"MEASURES FOR QUALITY ENRICHMENT AND SUSTENANCE IN HIGHER EDUCATION INSTITUTIONS"

About the Symposium: Quality in higher education is a multi-dimensional, multi-level and dynamic concept that relates to the contextual settings of an educational model, to the institutional mission and objectives, as well as to specific standards within a given system, institution, programme, or discipline. A higher education institution (HEI) needs to follow an external evaluation procedure in order to assess its quality and to acquire the provisional functioning authorization, followed by its official accreditation, as well as the accreditation of its study programmes. This makes it imperative that the affiliating university takes an initiative in enabling affiliating colleges to discuss the measures required for quality management in terms of quality enrichment and sustenance in HEI. University of Mumbai has 793 affiliated colleges and thus it needs to fulfill its leadership role in equipping the IQAC co-ordinators and team members with knowledge, attitudes, values, ethics and skills necessary for quality enhancement and sustenance.

Objectives of the Symposium:

- 1. To discuss the relevance of quality enrichment and sustenance in HEIs in India in the context of international standards and trends.
- 2. To discuss institutionalization of the process of quality enrichment in HEIs.
- 3. To deliberate on the measures of enhancing quality and promote changes in HEIs with the aim of improving their effectiveness, efficiency and image.

Expected Outcome: It is expected that after attending the symposium, there would be better understanding, motivation and preparedness amongst colleges affiliated to University of Mumbai for assessment and accreditation process.

Expected Participants: Principals, IQAC Co-ordinators and IQAC team members of those colleges affiliated to the University of Mumbai which are not accredited or have a NAAC CGPA score less than 2.5. The symposium is aimed at catering to only those colleges which are affiliated to University of Mumbai and which have not yet gone for Assessment and Accreditation process.
