### How to Read the Timetable of T.Y.B.A.

#### Single major subject

1. The examination of students of T.Y.B.A. appearing with single major/ entire (with only one subject), except the subject of Sociology, will be conducted on the six consecutive days, according to the timetable starting from 28<sup>th</sup> December, 2018 to 7<sup>th</sup> January, 2019. For example, if a student who appears with a single major/entire subject of Marathi, his / her papers (IV, V, VI, VII, VIII, and IX) will be conducted continuously for the first six days starting from 28<sup>th</sup> December, 2018 to 7<sup>th</sup> January, 2019.

Students appearing with entire papers of Sociology for them according to the timetable examination are going to start from 28<sup>th</sup> December, 2018 to 15<sup>th</sup> January, 2019.

#### Double Major Subjects

2. The examination of students of T. Y. B. A. appearing with double majors (with two different subjects) will be conducted as per the subject code given below:

(A) The subject with the lowest paper code as per the subjects opted by the students will be held on the first three consecutive days according to the timetable starting from 28<sup>th</sup> December, 2018 to 2<sup>nd</sup> January, 2019.

(B) The subject with the highest paper code as per the subjects opted by the students will be held on the last three consecutive days according to the timetable starting from 8<sup>th</sup> January to 10<sup>th</sup> January, 2019.

For example, if a student appears with double major subjects of Sociology and History, paper code of History is 32 and that of Sociology is 33, hence his/her papers of History having the lowest paper code (i.e. 32) will be held on the first three consecutive days according to the timetable starting from 28<sup>th</sup> December, 2018 to 2<sup>nd</sup> January, 2019 and the papers of Sociology having the highest paper code (i.e. 33) will be held on the last three consecutive days according to the timetable starting from 8<sup>th</sup> January to 10<sup>th</sup> January, 2019.

3. Student appearing with double majors (with two different subjects) has to note that his/her first group of papers (IV, V, VI) will be conducted from 28<sup>th</sup> December, 2018 to 2<sup>nd</sup> January, 2019 and the other group of papers (IV, V, VI) will be conducted from 8<sup>th</sup> January to 10<sup>th</sup> January 2019.

4. Timetable of the subject/s opted by the students will be printed on their hall tickets. The details of hall tickets, centers will be updated on the website <http://mu.ac.in/portal/distance-open-learning/> & <http://idolooa.digitaluniversity.ac/> before four days of the commencement of the examination.

5. Students opted for Geography Subject are hereby inform that there will be practical Examination conducted for them for Paper No. VI & paper No. IX. the Schedule for the practical examination will be soon displayed on website: <http://mu.ac.in/portal/distance-open-learning/>
