M.A. in Russian ( the programme is Semester & Credit based )

Fees: As per University rules.

Duration : Two academic years.

Eligibility:

- a) Graduation in Russian from the University of Mumbai  
Or
- b) Graduation in Russian from any other recognized University
- c) Graduation in any other subject and Advanced Diploma / Equivalent qualification in Russian  
and an Entrance Test to be conducted by the Department.

Two written papers and an Interview as per the tentative schedule given below:

- Paper I on Monday, 31<sup>st</sup> August, 2015, 12.00 noon. – 01.00 p.m.  
(Paper I will test the general competence in Russian from the point of view of grammar and essay writing)
- Paper II on Monday, 31<sup>st</sup> August, 2015, 01.00 noon. – 02.00 p.m.  
(Paper II will test the ability to comprehend literary texts, and the ability to translate newspaper material from Russian to English)
- Interview at 3.30 pm on Monday, 31<sup>st</sup> August, 2015.
