INSTRUCTIONS FOR CANDIDATES

- 1) Application shall be completed in all respects and must be submitted on or before **25th June, 2019 till 5.00 pm** at the Office of **Rajiv Gandhi Centre for Contemporary Studies, 1st Floor, Rajiv Gandhi Bhavan, Beside Sanskrit Bhavan, University of Mumbai, Mumbai – 400 098.** (Applications received thereafter will not be entertained)
- 2) *Applications must be filled legibly.*
- 3) *The date for the Common Entrance Test followed by Group Discussion will be held on 28th June 2019. Personal interviews will be held on 29th June, 2019.*
- 4) The list of selected students for admission to the MSW will be exhibited on the Centre's Notice board on 1st July 2019.
- 5) Candidates selected for admission are required to pay the fees and enroll themselves in the Centre between 2nd July to 6th July, 2019.
- 6) Applicants are requested to inform the Centre Office within 5 days from the date of publication of the list of selected candidates in case they do not wish to avail themselves of the seats offered, so as to enable the Centre to allot the vacant seats to the students on the waiting list. The students who fail to enroll within the period of 5 days will be allotted to others on the waiting list.
- 7) Graduates other than the University of Mumbai are required to submit their Self attested mark sheets for all the three years of graduation for verification in the office of the Rajiv Gandhi Centre for Contemporary Studies.
- 8) Graduates of Universities other than the University of Mumbai are required to submit the Migration Certificate from their Graduating University within one week of taking admission in this University. Please note that it is the responsibility of the applicant to get the Migration Certificate, Mark Sheets and Verification of Mark Sheet from his/her University in time. In case the applicant is not able to get the migration certificate in time, their admission is liable to get cancelled.
- 9) The applicant should be a graduate from any discipline from the recognized universities. The copies of the statements of marks obtained by applicants at the examination, certified by the Principal of a constituent college / the Head of a recognized institution or a Magistrate should be submitted. Further, the mark sheets must be in printed format only and NOT HAND-WRITTEN.
- 10) Application form must be completed in all respects and this will be provisional admission till your eligibility is cleared by University of Mumbai.
- 11) This is Self-financed course. University does not guarantee any reimbursement of fee unless government of Maharashtra sanctions fee concession/fellowship/scholarship to the SC/ST/DTNT/OBC/SBC category students. Reservation in admission will be applicable as per University of Mumbai and Government of Maharashtra rules and regulation
- 12) No enquiries will be entertained in case a student fails to secure admission.

- The Candidate will thus be graded out of a total of 100 marks.
- Candidates for Group Discussion and Interview will be shortlisted on the basis of the marks achieved in Past Academic Record. (15), English Comprehension (15) and General Knowledge (10) taken together that is on the basis of marks scored out of 40.
- In the General Knowledge and the AIMS Test, Candidates will be tested on current social issues and debates in the country like health, education, development issues, tribal and rural welfare etc, and issues pertaining to the marginalized sections.
- Candidates whose Final Year Bachelors' exam results are awaited will be allowed to appear for the Written Test, Group Discussion and Interview if shortlisted.
