The University of Mumbai, known earlier as University of Bombay is amongst the first three universities established in India in 1857 by the then British Government.

The Department of Education was established in the year 1974 and is situated in the Maulana Abul Kalam Azad Bhavan, Vidyanagari, Kalina, Mumbai. The Department conducts Post Graduate degree, diploma and certificate courses as well as Doctoral Course in Education.

The Rajabai Tower library building of the university is a two storeyed structure, built in Gothic Revival style. The building is considered not only as university's pride, but pride for the city of Mumbai for its architectural beauty. It is enriched with the rare books, manuscripts, personal collections, letters, diaries of eminent thinkers and educationalists.

The growing collection of the university library and the demands of the patron resulted into the construction of a new building at the Kalina campus which is named as Jawaharlal Nehru Library. Presently it has a collection of more than 8 lakhs of books and other material in almost all the major languages.

The Department of Library and Information Science, University of Mumbai was established in the year 1943. It is one of the early departments in the country to start formal Library Science Education. The former Diploma Course was changed to degree as Bachelor of Library Science in 1964. The Master in Library Science was introduced in 1968. The nomenclature changed to Library and Information Science in the year 1996. The Department has produced some of the finest library professionals in the country who have made outstanding contribution to the profession. Currently it conducts Master of Library and Information Science and Ph. D courses.

Introduction

Referencing is an important part of scholarly writing because it adds to the shared knowledge of all involved in an academic area. Using others' ideas in your academic writing without appropriate acknowledgement is regarded as a form of intellectual dishonesty. In academic environment this is called as plagiarism and it is seen as a very serious offence. Referencing acts as an important tool for preventing plagiarism. It also demonstrates that researcher has read widely on the topic. It also lends credibility to the research. It allows the researcher to follow-up references and to check the validity of arguments. It has been found that researchers often struggle to understand 'how to', 'when to' and why aspects of referencing.

Thus this workshop covers the scientific methods of citing and acknowledging sources of information.
