Eligibility : Graduates from any recognized universities may apply, including those awaiting the results of the Bachelor's Degree Examination

Admission forms will be available at the office of the Department of Sociology, 1st Floor, M.G. Ranade Bhavan, University of Mumbai, Vidyanagari, Kalina, Santacruz East, Mumbai – 400 098 on payment of a fee of ₹100/-, right after the declaration of the results of Third Year B.A. examinations of the University of Mumbai.

Application forms & Eligibility form can be downloaded online. However, the candidates are required to submit in person to the Department of Sociology the forms duly filled up.

Kindly Note:

- Direct admission to those students who have passed BA with six papers in Sociology
- Interviews will be taken of those students who have passed BA with three papers in Sociology
- There will be a Faculty Change Test for students from other Faculties and Disciplines
- Students from other than the University of Mumbai are required to get Provisional Eligibility Certificate for taking admission
- Eligibility fees of ₹ 220 /- for students from universities in Maharashtra and fees of ₹ 320/- for students from other University (other than Maharashtra state) will have to be submitted in cash to the department of sociology.
- Enrollment fees for students belonging to university other than Mumbai university is fees of ₹ 220/-.
- Document Required for M.A. admission: Two Photos, T.Y.B.A. Marksheet & Degree Certificate & for Reserved category students – Caste Certificate (all attested copy).

Entrance Test will be held after ten days of the declarations of the results of the B.A. Examinations conducted by the University of Mumbai.

Performance at the Entrance Test as well as the grades/marks received at the Bachelor's Degree Examination will be considered for deciding on admission.

First Semester commences on **4th July, 2016.**
