Instructions to the Candidates

- 1) Each day there will be *two practical sessions*.
Session I: 9:00 a.m. to 12.00 noon and Session II: 1.00 p.m. to 4.00 p.m.
- 2) The practical on any given DAY are paired as follows:
 - a) **USCSP07 (Advance Java – II & Linux)**
 - b) **USCSP08 (Project Documentation & Project Development)**
- 3) You should be present at the place of your examination *at least 30 minutes before the commencement* of the examination along with your *ID-Card and Hall Ticket*. Possession of both of which is **ABSOLUTELY COMPULSORY**.
- 4) You should bring with you, a *certified journal (for USCSP07)* and *certified project documentation (for USCSP08)*. All of these should bear your *University Examination Seat Number on the cover*.
- 5) You will *not be allowed* to keep *any books, notes or papers, CDs, Pen Drives, Card Reader* or any other kind of *memory storage devices* with you *except writing stationary* in the Practical Laboratory.
- 6) **Do NOT carry Mobile Phones in the Laboratory**. Possession of *Mobile Phone* (even in **SWITCH OFF** mode) will be treated as **MALPRACTICE** and will *invite strictest punishment*.
- 7) Use *an ink pen or a ballpoint pen* for your writing work.
- 8) All the *projects should be loaded* in the directory named **“UMFH18\University Seat number”** under the root of the file system. All the *project data* should be solely *in that subdirectory only*. Ensure that your *project can be demonstrated, within the laboratory, to the examiner*. Do the *proper settings* of your project well in advance.
- 9) You will *perform the practical* as per the *instructions given to you on the slip* that you pick up.
- 10) *Feel free to ask the examiner* for clarification about anything that you do not understand in the slip. **In no circumstances, candidates are allowed to talk with other candidates.**
- 11) Your *program and everything pertaining to it must be stored* only in the subdirectory bearing your *University Seat Number* located under the **UMFH18 directory**, which is located directly under the root of the file system(For Example C:\)
- 12) You **MUST show the final program** to the examiner *before terminating* your practical session.
- 13) You have to *take print out of source code of the Adv JAVA program* and have to *write Linux commands / script in your answer sheet after completing the program or after two hours of the commencement of the practical session, whichever is earlier*.
- 14) Marks will be assigned on the following basis:
FOR PRACTICAL
 - a) The correctness of the program.
 - b) The logic used to arrive at the solution.
 - c) Program readability.
 - d) The test data and the output.
 - e) Viva-Voce (*will be mostly confined to the topic related to the practical that you are attempting*)**FOR PROJECT**
 - a) Preliminary Investigation : 10 marks
 - b) System Analysis: 10 marks
 - c) System Design: 10 marks
 - d) Coding & Implementation: 20 marks
 - e) Project Quality: 20 marks
 - f) Working of project: 20 marks
 - g) Student’s presentation: 10 marks
- 15) **Candidates not observing above instructions / instructions issued by examiners will be reported to the University Authorities and shall face the consequences.**
