To 2.30 PM. in the Department of Law, Room no. 122, 1st Floor, Fort Campus, University of Mumbai, Fort, Mumbai 400032.

For admission to First year of integrated Five Year B.B.A.-LL.B. Course, the following documents along with their attested photocopies are required along with the requisite fees

7. For Reserved Category Candidate
 - a) Caste Certificate issued by competent authority
 - b) Caste Validity Certificate issued by competent authority

- c) Non-Creamy Layer Certificate issued by competent authority (For reserved category Candidates except SC & ST categories)
8. Fees to be paid by Demand draft issued by any Nationalized Bank

For General Category – Rs. 50,000

Important Instructions

The students have to produce photo copied Marksheets and Certificates Sets attested by a Gazette Officer or Principal or Head of Educational Institution or Notary Public and the Domicile / Caste / Non-Creamy Layer / Validity Certificates in **THE NAME OF THE CANDIDATE** for those students who are seeking Admission under the Reserved Categories. The Candidates shall **HAVE** to bring the **ORIGINAL DOCUMENTS** as mentioned above too at the time of taking Admission.

The Demand Draft for the Open Category Candidates shall be for Rupees **FIFTY THOUSAND ONLY (Rs. 50000/-)** and for the Reserved Category Students, amount of fees Shall be Rupees **FIFTEEN THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED ONLY (Rs. 15,500)**. No payment of Fees by Cash / Money Order / Postal Order / Personal Cheques shall be accepted under any circumstances. The Full Name of the Candidate and the Phone Contact Number should be clearly mentioned behind the Demand Draft.

The Admission Process will be scheduled on Saturday, 28th of August, 2015 only. The Timings shall be from 11.30 AM till 2.30 PM. in the Department of Law, Room No. 122, 1st Floor, Fort Campus, University of Mumbai, Mumbai

If Candidates fails to appear for an interview or secure admission or fail to produce any requisite documents then he/she will loose his/her claim for admission & then Other candidates will be given chance in place of them in order of Merit

NOTE :

1. This is a full time course so students need to be present in the campus during working hours.
2. As per university rules 75% attendance is mandatory.
3. Participation in practical exercise is compulsory
4. Student who remains absent or fails in practical examination have to reappear for the exam of entire year
5. Dress Code : Formals with Black trousers and white shirt is compulsory
6. Ragging is prohibited as per University Rules. Students have to give an undertaking for anti-ragging.
