



Guidelines for examination and results processing related to equivalent/alternate subjects for UG and PG courses of engineering faculty.

All candidates having backlog of R-2007 Scheme of syllabus given equivalence in R-2012 scheme of UG programs,

1. Those who were having backlog of semester III TO VI and given equivalence course in semester I, II, VII and VIII, examination related documents such as attendance, supervisor reports, answer books etc. to be maintained separately at institute level. Answer books to be assessed and results prepared at institute level only. Separate ledger of results to be submitted to university for approval.
2. Those who were having backlog of semester VII TO VIII and given equivalence course in lower semesters (III, IV, V and VI), examination related documents such as attendance, supervisor reports, answer books etc. to be maintained separately at institute level. Answer books to be assessed and results prepared at institute level only. Final results of these students to be communicated to university for declaration of result.
3. Those who were having more than one backlog and wherein different courses are given as equivalence courses, but do to constraints in scheduling examination time table of university, candidates have to appear examination of more than one course on same day and time, which is practically not possible, in all these cases it is resolved that, "students result of one course shall be considered for remaining courses as per equivalence approved".
4. In R-2007 Scheme maximum marks of theory examination is 100, wherein in R-2012 Scheme maximum marks is 80. To solve this issue, it is resolved that, "students taken admission in R-2007 scheme and now appearing for equivalence examination in R-2012 scheme, marks obtained by candidates shall be scaled up to out of 100 marks."
5. If for any theory course in R-2007 equivalence is given for laboratory course in R-2012 scheme, practical examination marks obtained shall be scaled up as per theory examination scheme of R-2007.

All candidates having backlog of R-2012 Scheme of syllabus given equivalence in R-2016 scheme of PG programs,

1. Those who were having more than one backlog and wherein different courses are given as equivalence courses, but do to constraints in scheduling examination time table of university, candidates have to appear examination of more than one course on same day and time, which is practically not possible, in all these cases it is resolved that, "students result of one course shall be considered for remaining courses as per equivalence approved".
2. In Mechanical all PG programs for R-2012 scheme elective II and elective IV courses are given equivalence as Institute level optional course I and II respectively in R-2016 scheme of syllabus.
