### Part A-Terms and Conditions

### Terms and Conditions of Supply:

The tender document along with terms & conditions are available for sale on https://dhe.maharashtra.etenders.in.

- 1. Tenderer/Bidders shall submit the following documents along with their tender and be placed in the Technical Bid Envelope i.e. Envelope No. 1).
  - a) Income-Tax clearance certificate from the Income-Tax Officer concerned, certifying that the tenderer has cleared all the Income -Tax dues.
  - b) Tenderers should be either manufacturer or authorized dealer of the said equipment and should submit the proof for the same. Also, the Tenderers should state whether they are a Proprietary Firm, Partnership Firm or a Private/Public Limited Company and furnish the proof of the same. If the tenderer is a partnership firm, the necessary partnership deed, disclosing the names of all partners and their interest in the firm shall be enclosed.
  - c) Tenderer should enclose the list of names of the organizations and laboratories to which similar equipment has been supplied and a certificate to the effect that the performance of the supplied equipment was satisfactory.
  - d) Sales Tax Registration No. / VAT Reg. No.
  - e) Technical specifications offered by the Supplier.
  - f) Proprietary certificate
  - g) The authority to sign the tender document shall be submitted invariably by the tenderer.
  - h) Affidavit on Rs. 100/- Stamp Paper
  - i) Declaration on Stamp Paper as per format given in the tender document.
  - Vendor must submit Compliance statement in tabular form comparing each specification of the quoted item with that given in the Tender Document part B.



- 2. Supplier should read carefully all the instructions and terms and conditions, etc., before registering rates in prescribed schedule of the tender. Taxes and duties etc. should be shown separately
- 3. The offers made by the suppliers shall be open for acceptance for 120 days after the last date of submission of tender.
- 4. The quotation shall be opened by the Head, Department of Chemistry in his office on 09/03/2017. The tenderers or their authorized representatives shall be allowed to be present at the time of opening of the tenders.
- 5. In case of imported items / equipments the rates should be quoted in the light of exemptions enjoyed by educational institutions. The University is exempted from payment of Customs/Excise duty, Octroi; and the necessary certificates / forms can be issued by the University.
- 6. Technical specifications of the instrument are given in the Annexure of these papers (Part B).
- 7. The delivery time of instrument / equipment should be clearly mentioned in the tender. No extension shall be granted to the contractors / suppliers for the period of delivery mentioned in the tender, under any circumstances.
- 8. If the supplier fails to deliver the article as per the delivery schedule, the University of Mumbai shall be free to procure the balance / undelivered supply, at the risk and cost of such supplier.
- 9. The goods, article, material supplied by the contractor shall be accepted after inspection by an officer authorized by the competent authority. No article / material which do not conform to the specifications laid down in the terms and conditions or damaged in transit or otherwise, shall be accepted.
- 10. The bills of the suppliers shall be paid by the University after all the article/ material/ instrument / equipment have been received, inspected as above.
- 11. Service Support should be from Factory trained Engineers; specifying the no. of Engineers with their names, mobile numbers, base location, Response time, etc.
- 12. Supplier should give free service at least for three years after the warranty is over.
- 13. Undertaking from the manufacturer that parts will be made available at least for next ten years even after discontinuation of the supplied model is necessary.
- 14. A list of spares/consumables required for hassle free functioning of the instrument for at least two years should be included.

# Technical Specifications for DLS system for measurement of particle size, zeta potential and molecular weight

PC controlled system for measurement of Particle size, Zeta Potential and Molecular weight of dispersed particles/molecules in solution.

Built in facility for flow mode operation with SEC (Size exclusion chromatography) to enable connection of 1 or 2 external detectors & a remote measurement start would be an added advantage.

The optics must be fully pre-aligned with no user adjustment required. Vendor should specify the arrangement for minimization of multiple scattering. Variable positioning within the cell to collect scattered light would be advantageous.

Measurement Type: Particle size, Molecular weight and Zeta potential

### **Particle Size:**

- a. Measurement Principle: Dynamic Light Scattering
- b. Size Range: 0.5nm to 8.0 microns (hydrodynamic diameter) or better
- c. Sample Conc. Range: 0.00001% to 40% (% volume) or better
- d. Accuracy: Better than +/- 2% of NIST traceable latex standards
- e. Precision/repeatability: Better than +/- 2% of NIST traceable latex standards
- f. Minimum sample volume (Particle Size): 20 µL (minimum) or lower

### Molecular Weight:

System should have capability to use variable detection positions within sample cuvette depending on sample's scattering ability & sample concentration in order to minimize multiple scattering effects. Vendor must specify the number of positions available to avoid multiple scattering (Larger the better).

**Detector:** Avalanche Photo Diode for high sensitivity measurements.



Temperature control range: 2-80°C or better

### **Sampling Cell:**

- a. Cuvette cell compatible with aqueous & non aqueous samples (Universal dip cell).
- b. 12 mm square disposable polystyrene cuvettes with stoppers for size measurement: 100 in numbers.

# A. Pre-requisites to participate in the Tenders processed by UNIVERSITY OF MUMBAI:

# 1. Registration of Contractors on Electronic Tendering System on Sub – Portal of MUMBAI UNIVERSITY:

The Contractors **Non Registered** in **MUMBAI UNIVERSITY** and interested in participating in the e-Tendering process of **MUMBAI UNIVERSITY** shall be required to enroll on the Electronic Tendering System. To enroll contractor has to generate User ID and password on the <a href="https://maharashtra.etenders.in">https://maharashtra.etenders.in</a>

Once the ID is generated the Contractor can login into the eTendering portal of Government of Maharashtra. The process of Enrolment is explained in Step

The Bid Data that is prepared online is required to be encrypted and the hash value of the Bid Data is required to be signed electronically using a **Digital Certificate** (**Class – II or Class – III**). This is required to maintain the security of the Bid Data and also to establish the identity of the Contractor transacting on the System. **This Digital Certificate** should be having Two Pair(1. Sign Verification 2. Encryption/ Decryption)

The Digital Certificates are issued by an approved Certifying Authority authorized by the Controller of Certifying Authorities of Government of India through their Authorized Representatives upon receipt of documents required to obtain a Digital Certificate.

Bid data / information for a particular Tender may be submitted only using the Encryption Digital

Certificate which is used to encrypt the data / information and Signing Digital Certificate to sign the hash value during the *Bid Preparation and Hash Submission* stage. In case, during the process of preparing and submitting a Bid for a particular Tender, the Contractor loses his / her Digital Signature Certificate (i.e. due to virus attack, hardware problem, operating system problem); he / she may not be able to submit the Bid online. Hence, the Users are advised to store his / her Digital Certificate securely and if possible, keep a backup at safe place under adequate security to be used in case of need.

In case of online tendering, if the Digital Certificate issued to an Authorized User of a Partnership Firm is used for signing and submitting a bid, it will be considered equivalent to a no objection certificate / power of attorney to that User to submit the bid on behalf of the Partnership Firm. The Partnership Firm has to authorize a specific individual via an authorization certificate signed by a partner of the firm (and in case the applicant is a partner, another partner in the same form is required to authorize) to use the digital certificate as per *Indian Information Technology Act*, 2000.

Unless the Digital Certificate is revoked, it will be assumed to represent adequate authority of the Authority User to bid on behalf of the Firm for the Tenders processed on the Electronic Tender Management System of Government of



Maharashtra as per *Indian Information Technology Act*, 2000. The Digital Signature of this Authorized User will be binding on the Firm. It shall be the responsibility of Partners of the Firm to inform the Certifying Authority or Sub Certifying Authority, if the Authorized User changes, and apply for a fresh Digital Signature Certificate. The procedure for application of a Digital Signature Certificate will remain the same for the new Authorized User.

Steps to be followed by Contractors to participate in the e-Tenders processed by MUMBAI UNIVERSITY.

### 1. Preparation of online Briefcase

All Contractors enrolled on the Electronic Tendering System of Government of Maharashtra are provided with



dedicated briefcase facility to store documents / files in digital format. The Contractors can use the online briefcase to store their scanned copies of frequently used documents / files to be submitted as a part of their bid response. The Contractors are advised to store the relevant documents in the briefcase before starting the Bid Preparation and submission stage.

In Case, the Contractors have multiple documents under the same type (e.g. multiple Work Completion Certificates) as mentioned above, the Contractors advised to either create a single .pdf or .jpgfile of all the documents of same type or compress the documents in a single compressed file in .zip or .rar formats and upload the same.

If the payment is not realized with bank, in that case system will not be able to validate the payment and will not allow the bidder to complete his Bid Preparation stage resulting in non participation in the aforesaid eTender.

### Note:

- \* Relaisation of NEFT/RTGS payment normally takes 2 to 24 hours, so it is advised to make sure that NEFT.RTGS payment activity should be completed well before time.
- \* NEFT/RTGS option will be depend on the amount of EMD.
- \* Help file regarding use of e Payment Gateway can be downloaded from e Tendering portal.

Submission of Bids will be preceded by online bid preparation and submission of the digitally signed Bid Hashes (Seals) within the Tender Time Schedule (Key dates) published in the Detailed Notice Inviting Tender. The Bid Data is to be prepared in the templates provided by the Tendering Authority of **MUMBAI UNIVERSITY**. The templates may be either form based, extensible tables and / or up loadable documents. In the form based type of templates and extensible table type of templates, the Contractors are required to enter the data and encrypt the data using the Digital Certificate.

In case Up loadable document type of templates, the Contractors are required to select the relevant document / compressed file (containing multiple documents) already uploaded in the briefcase.

### Notes:

- a. The Contractors upload a single documents or a compressed file containing multiple documents against each unloadable option.
- b. The Hashes are the thumbprint of electronic data and are based on one way algorithm. The Hashes establish the unique identity of Bid Data.
- c. The Bid hash values are digitally signed using valid class II or Class III Digital Certificate issued any Certifying Authority. The Contractors are required to obtain Digital Certificate in advance.
- d. After the hash value of bid is generated, the Contractors cannot make any change / addition in its bid data. The bidder may modify bids before the deadline for Bid Preparation and Hash Submission as per Time Schedule mentioned in the Tender documents.
- e. This stage will be applicable during both. Pre-bid / Pre-qualification and Financial Bidding Processes.



### 5. Close for Bidding (Generation of Super Hash Values):

After the expiry of the cut- off time of Bid Preparation and Hash Submission stage to be completed by the Contractors has lapsed, the Tender will be closed by the Tender Authority.

The Tender Authority from **MUMBAI UNIVERSITY** shall generate and digitally sign the Super Hash values (Seals).

### 6. Decryption and Re-encryption of bids (submitting the Bids online):

After the time for generation of super hash values by the Tender Authority from MUMBAI UNIVERSITY has lapsed, the Contractors have to make the online payment of Rs. 1,063/-(882+Payment Gateway Charges+Service Tax) towards the fees of the Service Provider. After making online payment towards fees of Services provider, the Contractors are required to decrypt their bid data using their Digital Certificate and immediately re-encrypt their bid data using the public key of the Tendering Authority. The Public Key of the Tendering Authority is attached to the Tender during the Close for Bidding stage.

Note: The details of the Processing Fees shall be verified and matched during the Technical Opening stage.

At this time the Contractors are also required to upload the files for which they generated the Hash values during the Bid Preparation and Hash Submission Stage.

The Bid Data and Documents of only those Contractors who have submitted their Bid Hashes (Seals) Within the stipulated time (as per the Tender Time Schedule), will be available for decryption and re-encryption and to upload the relevant documents from Briefcase. A Contractor who has not submitted his Bid Preparation and Hash Submission stage within the stipulated time will not be allowed to decrypt / re-encrypt the bid data / submit documents during the stage of decryption and Re-encryption of bids (submitting the bids online).

### 7. Short listing of Contractors for Financial Bidding Process:

The Tendering Authority will first open the Technical Bid documents of all Contractors and after scrutinizing these documents will shortlist the Contractors who are eligible for Financial Bidding Process. The short listed Contractors will be intimated by email.

### 8. Opening of the Financial Bids:

The Contractors may remain present in the office of the Tender Opening Authority at the time of opening of Financial Bids. However, the results of the Financial Bids of all Contractors shall be available on the **MUMBAI UNIVERSITY** e-Tendering Portal immediately after the completion of opening process.

### 9. Tender Schedule (Key Dates):

The Contractors are strictly advised to follow the Dates and Times allocated to each stage under the column "Contractor Stage" as indicated in the Time Schedule in the Detailed tender Notice for the Tender. All the online



activities are time tracked and the electronic Tendering System enforces time-locks that ensure that no activity or transaction can take place outside the Start and End Dates and time of the stage as defined in the Tender Schedule.

At the sole discretion of the tender Authority, the time schedule of the Tender stages may be extended.
