The Principals/Directors of all affiliated/ Recognised Colleges/ Institutions are hereby requested as per letter F No. 3-4/2017-NER dated 15th October, 2019 from Dr. V. L. V. S. S. SubbaRao, Sr. Economics Advisor (Higher Education), regarding Certain concessions for the wards of Kashmiri migrants for their admission in Higher Education Institutions in other parts of the country.

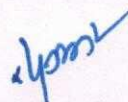
In this connection, representations have been received from Kashmiri Pandits (Non-Migrants) living in the Kashmir Valley to extend the existing concessions being provided to Kashmiri Migrants for them also.

The matter has been considered in this Department in consultation with Ministry of Home Affairs and State Government of Jammu & Kashmir, Now it has been decided to allow the following concessions to the wards of Kashmiri Migrants as well as Kashmiri Pandits/ Kashmiri Hindu Families (Non-Migrants) who are living in the Kashmir Valley, in the matter of their admission in the educational institutions in other parts of the country from the academic year 2020-21 and onwards till further orders:

- (i) Relaxation in cut-off percentage upto 10% subject to minimum eligibility requirement.
- (ii) Increase in intake capacity upto 5% course-wise
- (iii) Reservation of at least one seat in merit quota in technical/ professional institutions.
- (iv) Waiving off domicile requirements for Kashmiri Migrants only. Kashmiri Pandits/ Kashmiri Hindu Families (Non-Migrants) living in the Kashmir Valley need domicile certificate.

The Principals/Directors of all affiliated/ Recognised Colleges/ Institutions are hereby requested to Kindly do the needful in the above matter.
