Attention of the Principals of the Affiliated Colleges, Directors of the recognized Institutions in Science & Technology Faculty is invited to this office circular No. UG/159 of 2018-19, dated 20th March, 2019 relating to the B.E. degree (CBSGS).

They are hereby informed that the recommendations made by the Board of Deans at its meeting held on 20th March, 2019 have been accepted by the Academic Council at its meeting held on 26th July, 2019 <u>vide</u> item No. 4.36 and subsequently approved by the Management Council at its meeting held on 13th September, 2019 <u>vide</u> item No. 16 and that in accordance therewith, in exercise of the powers conferred upon the Management Council under Section 74(4) of the Maharashtra Public Universities Act, 2016 (Mah. Act No. VI of 2017) and the amended <u>Ordinance 6262 regarding to the B.E. degree (CBSGS)</u>, has been brought into force with effect from the academic year 2019-20, accordingly. (The same is available on the University's website <u>www.mu.ac.in</u>) and to read as under:-

Existing Ordinance 6262

A learner who has passed the Bachelor of Engineering degree examination of the university and who wish to improve their CGPI be permitted to appear again for the same examination with the same courses. The learner may appear Semester VII and VIII together or separately but all courses of Semester VII together and all courses of semester VIII together without being required to keep any term again. This Provision shall be applicable subsequent to the first passing of the degree examination for not more than three consecutive examinations conducted by the University. Marks obtained by the candidate in term-work, internal assessment, practical and/or oral examination, seminar and project of semester VII and Semester VIII shall be carried forward for not more than three consecutive examinations.

Amended Ordinance 6262

A learner who has passed the Bachelor of Engineering degree examination of the University and who wish to improve their CGPI be permitted to appear again for the same examination with the same courses.

The learner may appear Semester III and IV together or separately but all courses of semester III together and all courses of semester IV together without being required to keep any term again. This provision shall be applicable subsequent to the first passing of the degree examination for not more than three consecutive examinations conducted by the University. Marks obtained by the candidate in term-work, internal assessment, practical and/or oral examination, etc. of semester III and semester IV shall be carried forward for not more than three consecutive examinations.

The learner may appear semester V and VI together or separately but all courses semester V together and all courses of semester VI together without being required to keep

any term again. This provision shall be applicable subsequent to the first passing of the degree examination for not more than three consecutive examinations conducted by the University. Marks obtained by the candidate in term-work, internal assessment, practical and/or oral examination, etc of semester V and semester VI shall be carried forward for not more than three consecutive examinations.

The learner may appear Semester VII and VIII together or separately but all courses of semester VII together and all courses of semester VIII together without being required to keep any term again. This provision shall be applicable subsequent to the first passing of the degree examination for not more than three consecutive examinations conducted by the University. Marks obtained by the candidate in term-work, internal assessment, practical and/or oral examination, seminar and project of semester VIII and semester VIII shall be carried forward for not more than three consecutive examinations
