



ANNOUNCEMENT OF THE FIRST ROUND OF PROGRAMMES FOR THE YEAR 2020-21: SHASTRI INDO-CANADIAN INSTITUTE

Shastri Indo-Canadian Institute has announced its **first round** of programmes for the year **2020-21**. Please note that all research in relation to the announced programmes will be done remotely by making use of online tools. Also, proposals need to be submitted based on the Institute's COVID-19 policy.

All university departments, institutes, Centres and conducted colleges of the University of Mumbai are eligible to apply. Applicants are encouraged to submit proposals timely to avoid the last-minute rush. The last-minute submission creates pressure on the Grant Management System (GMS) which results in slow processing or inactive sessions.

It intends to call for project proposals to conduct joint (applied) research (virtually) and provide solutions to deal with both the immediate and long-term effects of the global crisis in terms of building new devices, creating new knowledge, development of the vaccine, new methods of treatment & diagnosis, and ways of dealing with the socio-economic and psychosocial consequences of the outbreak, so as to address the urgency created by Covid-19. As an objective, this grant also aims to build on the strengths of diverse and interdisciplinary teams of Indian and Canadian member institutions of SICI of two or more researchers to meet the assigned goals.
