- Direct admission to those students who have passed BA with six papers in Sociology
- Interviews will be taken of those students who have passed BA with three papers in Sociology
- There will be a Faculty Change Test for students from other Faculties and Disciplines
- Students from other than the University of Mumbai are required to get Provisional Eligibility Certificate for taking admission
- Eligibility fees for students from universities in Maharashtra and fees for students from other University (other than Maharashtra state) will have to be submitted to the department of sociology.
- Enrollment fees for students belonging to university other than Mumbai University.
- Document Required for M.A. admission: Two Photos, T.Y.B.A. Mark sheet and Degree Certificate and Caste Certificate for Reserved category students. (all self-attested copy)
- Last date for submission of Registration form is: 25 November 2020

Entrance Test will be held for other faculty students. Syllabus, date and time will be communicated on your registered email or mobile.

Performance at the Entrance Test and interview as well as the grades/marks received at the Bachelor's Degree Examination will be considered for deciding admission.
