BOS in Pharmacy was held on 19th November, 2019

- Equivalence for transfer of students passed from CBCS 2016 syllabus to Revised 2019 syllabus
 - Students of CBCS 2016 syllabus who have taken drop in FY, SY and T.Y.B.Pharm. course need to PASS in all the subjects of the same syllabus and those who PASS the CBCS 2016 syllabus can be allowed to integrate with the CBCS Revised 2019 syllabus.
 - Once in Revised 2019 syllabus the rules of cumulative GPA will be applicable to those students. The SGPA of CBCS syllabus 2016 will be carried forward to Revised - 2019 to calculate the final CGPA.
 - While integrating students from Syllabus 2016 to syllabus Revised*-2019, bridge courses shall be conducted at the Institute level. The institute shall conduct examination and issue certificate of completion of bridge courses with credits assigned. These credits shall be entered in the marksheet separately, **however the credits shall not be considered in calculation of SGPA and subsequently CGPA.** Successful completion of these bridge courses is mandatory for the award of B.Pharm. Degree to the students integrated from syllabus 2016 to syllabus Revised - 2019 w.e.f. 2020-2021.

(This resolution to be submitted for approval of the Academic Authorities and Management Council as may be necessary.)
