They are hereby informed that the recommendations made by the Ad-hoc Board of Studies in Law at its online meeting held on 3rd February, 2021 vide item No.4 and subsequently passed by the Board of Deans at its online meeting held on 11th February, 2021 vide item No. 8.8 have been accepted by the Academic Council at its meeting held on 23rd February, 2021 vide item No.8.7 and that in accordance therewith, the revise syllabus of "Torts and Consumer Protection Laws" which is a compulsory paper for LL.B. 3 yrs and LL.B. 5 yrs in semester I and V respectively by replacing the new 2019 Act in the place of the old 1986 Act which is repealed has been brought into force with effect from the academic year 2021-22, accordingly.
