Online LL.M. Common Entrance Test Guidelines for Admission to LL.M. Programme – 2021-2022

The Department of Law, University of Mumbai is conducting Online LL.M. Common Entrance Exam for admission of LL.M. (Two Years) Programme for the academic year 2021-2022.

Eligibility: Candidates who have passed LL.B._or those who have appeared for the <u>Final Semester Examinations of 3 or 5 year LL.B. Programme</u> from the University of Mumbai or any other recognized University are eligible to apply for online LL.M. Common Entrance Examination 2021.

Candidates who are currently pursuing LL.M. will be required to cancel their earlier LL.M. Admission before admission to the new LL.M. Programme.

Application for Online LL.M. Entrance Examination should be made in the prescribed form which is available on the following website:

ADMISSION TO LL.M TWO YEAR PROGRAMME SHALL BE MADE STRICTLY IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE MERIT LIST OF THE LL.M. ENTRANCE EXAMINATION 2021, RESERVATION POLICY OF THE GOVERNMENT OF MAHARASHTRA AND THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE UNIVERSITY OF MUMBAI.

Candidates are required to secure at least Minimum Qualifying Marks in the LL.M. Entrance Examination as under:

40 Marks - For General Category and 30 Marks - For Reserved Category

The LL.M. Entrance Examination Test paper will consist of 50 Objective type questions (multiple choice) for a total of 100 marks. There shall be no negative marking for wrong answers.

- 3. CANDIDATES APPLYING FOR QUOTA [DIVYANG (DIFFERENTLY ABLED), FIGHTER, ORPHAN, WIDOW, EX-SERVICEMAN, CULTURAL ACTIVITY ETC.] SHOULD **SUBMITTHEIR RESPECTIVE** CERTIFICATESISSUED BYCOMPETENT **AUTHORITY WHEREVER** APPLICABLE.
- 4. CANDIDATES BELONGING TO ECONOMICALLY WEAKER SECTION SHOULD SUBMIT A COPY OFELIGIBILITYCERTIFICATE FOR ECONOMICALLY WEAKER SECTIONISSUED BY THE GOVERNMENT OF MAHARASHTRA.
