- 1. The New Education Policy (NEP 2020) emphasizes upon making students global citizens. Teaching a technologically and culturally advanced foreign language like German is a step in this direction.

External Candidates with equivalent prerequisite competence shall be permitted to appear for the Advance Diploma III in German by paying a fees of Rs. 4000/- only when the final exam is held.

The University Department of German may hold this exam or a part of it in collaboration with an internationally recognized body and due fees may be collected by the department as per the understanding with the international organization so that the students may avail of an internationally recognized certification in addition to the Diploma Certificate for benefit of the students.

The marksheet / gradesheet must mention the Level C1 and 8 Credits.

This course shall be offered online/ offline/ blended learning format from the academic year 2021-22 onwards.
