



1 - Poor, 2 - Fair, 3 - Good, 4 - Very Good, 5 - Excellent Total Number of Respondents - 295


1. Curriculum is well structured and suitable for the desired program outcomes




#### 2. Objectives of the Curriculum are well defined and clear to teachers and students




# 3. The programme of studies carries sufficient number of optional courses




#### 4. The curriculum has good balance between theory and application




## 5. The Books prescribed/listed as reference material in curriculum are relevant and appropriate




#### 6. Sufficient number of prescribed books are available in the Library




## 7. Infrastructural facilities, necessary for teaching and learning are adequately available




#### 8. There is the freedom to propose, modify, suggest and incorporate new topics in the Curriculum




## 9. There is freedom to adopt new techniques/strategies of teaching
