The collated information will be shared with the ICSSR central Office.

This is to further inform the Social Science Students and the Social Science faculty from the Western Region that WRC/ICSSR, in pursuance of its aims and objectives, conducts as well as funds the research methodology workshops, other seminars, receives foreign visitors, administers study grants, provides hostel facilities, etc.

Some defined activities of the WRC/ICSSR have been:

1. To operate a study grant scheme under which travel costs and local maintenance charges at the prescribed rates are given to social scientists who come to Mumbai to avail themselves of the research material available, in accordance with the rules framed by the ICSSR;



- 2. To organize as well as fund training courses in Research Methodology in the social sciences as approved by the ICSSR from time to time;
- 3. To arrange as well as fund lectures, seminars and discussions for Indian social scientists with the help of eminent social scientists;
- 4. To undertake any other programs designed to promote and facilitate social science research in the region;
- 5. To support quality though limited Minor Research projects;
- 6. To extend book and journal grants;
- 7. To maintain a hostel where social scientists can stay at a minimal cost etc.
