- 3. Abstract (Not more than 250 words)
- 4. Keywords (4-5 words)

- 8. Conclusion
- 9. Acknowledgement
- 10. References (Follow sequ<mark>ence ci</mark>tation system)
- 11. Plagiarism Report
- The author can make subtitles as per one's requirement.
- The format for review paper would be as per the requirement of the topic.
- The length of paper should not exceed 3500 words.
- Introduce tables and figures wherever necessary.
