ELIGIBILITY:

M.Sc. (by Papers) Programme:

University of Mumbai, as per the resolution of the Ad-Hoc Committee in Life Sciences (appointed by the Academic Council) dated February 21, 2006, has provided eligibility guidelines to Candidates seeking M.Sc. Degree (by Papers) in Life Sciences. The relevant details as approved by the Academic Council are highlighted below:

- Candidates with the following combination of subjects will be eligible for admission to the M.Sc. Degree Course in Life Sciences:
- The Bachelor's Degree in Faculty of Science in the subjects of Life Sciences, Botany, Zoology, Microbiology, Biochemistry, Chemistry (with Biological Sciences at F.Y. and S.Y.), Biotechnology or Applied or Allied Biological Sciences of this University or equivalent Degree of recognised Universities.

OR

- The Bachelor's Degree in the Faculty of Medicine of this University or of recognised Universities.

OR

- The Bachelor's Degree in the Faculty of Technology of this University or of recognised Universities with the background of courses in Life Sciences.

OR

- The Bachelor's Degree in the Faculty of Agriculture of Veterinary Sciences of recognised Universities.

The Candidates will be entitled for admission to the M.Sc. Degree Course in Life Sciences only after passing the written test and viva/ interview to be conducted by the University Department of Life Sciences. The Programme for the written test and the interview will be as per the notification to be issued by the University Department of Life Sciences.

Further that 50 per cent of the seats allotted for the M.Sc. Degree in Life Sciences be reserved for students passing the B.Sc. Degree of this University with Life Sciences as their *single* major Subject.
