

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



As per the University letter No. APD/2020-21/63 dt. 21st August,2020, the Committee is constituted by the Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor to prepare the REPORT on required administrative/academic facilities, programmes, courses, manpower and resources to establish the Sub-Campus of University of Mumbai at Zarap in Sindhudurg-District (M.S.).

The Committee held its virtual meeting on 29th August, 2020, when all members were present. After going through the provisions of the Maharashtra Public Universities Act, 2016 and the discussion thereon, and discussing the terms of the Committee and the necessary follow up, it was decided to look into the important facets of establishing Sub-Campus to equip the students to accept challenges of life, come what may.

Preamble

To meet the demand and to achieve the aim of providing the facility of higher learning centre, the Maharashtra Public Universities Act, 2016 has made the provisions under Section 2 (60) as "'Sub-Campus' means a comprehensive inherent independent unit of the university for a predetermined geographical jurisdiction for decentralization of academic, administrative, research and extension activities of that jurisdiction, with the objective of improving efficiency and effectiveness".

Education has always been important in man's life, but more so in the modern world. In a world based on science and technology, the university has understood the significance of Sub-

Campus to serve the interior/hilly/tribal/rural area students. The great heritage of academic achievement of the University is based on the core idea of most effective utilization of the available resources and efforts to keep pace with "the needs of the environment".

The importance of Sub- Campus of the university is to provide an effective learning environment. The Campus is a small replica in which we can see the image of the society. Considering the magnitude of the need for Sub-Campus development, the 'Holistic' method is much needed.

It is true that from time immemorial man has been in search of truth and knowledge. His quest for truth leads him from the physical world to the spiritual, and from the natural to the supernatural. So is the relationship between Education Campus and learning.

Object to establish the Sub-Campus:

The object of Sub-campus, shall be to disseminate, create and preserve knowledge of a predetermined geographical jurisdiction and understanding by teaching, research and development, skill development, extension and service activities of that jurisdiction with the objective of efficiency and effectiveness. The objectives shall be to, -

- 1. To increase Gross Enrolment Ratio (GER).
- 2. To preserve cultural heritage.
- 3. To promote gender equality.
- 4. Generate and promote a sense of self- respect and dignity amongst the weaker section of the society.
- 5. To provide efficient and responsive administration, scientific and technology management.
- 6. To offer opportunities of new knowledge, training and skills in the context of modern communication media, information and communication technology etc.
- 7. To promote competitive merit in all academic and other matters relating to students.
- 8. To establish vocational/ skill knowledge based school.
- School of Inter-disciplinary studies to promote inter-disciplinary education and research
 on Sub-Campus and create an academic and research and development environment that
 allows free flow of ideas amongst several disciplines.
- 10. Understanding the diversity of the community.
- 11. Understanding the needs of the community.
- 12. To impart knowledge through the State language i.e. Marathi and international language i.e. English.
- 13. To provide modern education to all students.
- 14. To provide opportunities of higher education in professional programmes.

- 15. To provide equal opportunities to all i.e. to SC; ST; NT; DT; OBC and other minority communities.
- 16. To create and disseminate knowledge, equity, inclusivity, excellence, research and quality education.
- 17. Sub-Campus is an integral part of University and colleges imparting academic programmes, co-curricular, research and extension activities in rural or tribal region established with the object of reaching the unreached.

Functions of the Sub-Campus:

The Sub-Campus should encourage the students to become progressive and responsible citizens in their personal and social life. Education must be life building. The Sub-Campus and colleges play a crucial role in moulding young minds to think positively and help live an emotionally and spiritually healthy life. According to Dr. Radhakrishnan, 'It is the function of a University to build human beings, strive to rid them of their vanities and egotism and emancipate their minds from petty prejudices and narrow loyalties."


Sindhudurg District: Background:-

Sindhudurg District is a part of Konkan region of Maharashtra State. The total area is 5,207 sq.kms. It is divided in 8 Talukas viz. Dodamarg, Sawantwadi, Kudal, Vengurla, Malvan, kankavli, Devgad, Vaibhavwadi. It is surrounded by Ratnagiri District on the North and State of the Goa and Karnataka on the South. On the West Sindhudurg District boasts of 121 kms. of rich sea coast of Arabian sea and to the East across the crest of Western Ghats or Sahyadries is Kolhapur District. The District has its headquarters at SindhudurgNagari (Oros).

As per the 2011 census Sindhudurg District has population of 8,48,868, 0.76% of the State population. Its 87% population is rural and scattered across 743 villages. The main source of occupation and income is Agriculture, Horticulture, Fishing, mining, Tourism and allied activities. The district has very good network of infrastructure and can be approached by road, rail, air as well as sea. Its proximity and approachability to industrialized cities like Mumbai, Pune, Kolhapur, Belgaviand also the state of Goa provides ample scope of sustainable development and prosperity. There are still many vacant pockets and untapped resources that needs serious attention.

As per Sec. 21 (1) of the said Act, "Director Knowledge Resource Centre shall be a full time salaried officer of the university and shall be in-charge of the Knowledge Resource Centre in the Sub- Campus".

3. To promote sports, culture, and organize activities in the field of sports, cultivate excellence in various domains of sports and also to promote a spirit of healthy competition, there is a need of sports facilities and **Deputy Director** at Sub-Campus.

Appointment of teachers in Post-Graduate Department/s:

As per the Section 102 and Section 103 of the Maharashtra Public Universities Act, 2016 the required post/s of teacher/s on the basis of the workload in the concerned department/s and the provisions of this Act, Statutes and Ordinances to be filled.

Recommendation:

University's Sub-Campus can be thought of as philosophy, a process, and a plan guiding the process towards desired objectives. As per the Sec. 5(10) of the said Act, the University have the powers and duties to provide for establishment of Sub-Campuses for serving a group of colleges, and also to provide for and maintain common resources centres in such Sub-Campuses in the

resource centres, libraries, laboratories, computer centres, and the like centres of learning and charist training, as per the guidelines laid down by the State Government or the University Grants district. Therefore, we, the Committee members recommend to establish University Sub-Campus in Sindhudurg district to meet the regional disparities or imbalance in development exist in Sindhudurg in comparision with Mumbai and other developed regions.
