Attention of the Principals of the Affiliated Colleges and Directors of the Recognized Institutions in Faculty of Inter-Disciplinary Studies is invited to this office Circular No.UG/368 of 2001 dated 20th October, 2001, relating to the LL.B. degree course.

They are hereby informed that the recommendations made by the Ad-hoc Board of Studies in Law at its meeting held on 27th May, 2022 vide item No.1 (a) and subsequently passed in the faculty and then by the Board of Deans at its meeting held on 5th July, 2022 vide item No.8.5 (A) have been accepted by the Academic Council at its meeting held on 11th July, 2022 vide item No. 8.5 (A) and subsequently approved by the Management Council at its meeting held on 28th July, 2022 vide item No. 8 and that in accordance therewith, in exercise of the powers conferred upon the Management Council under Section 74(4) of the Maharashtra Public Universities Act, 2016 (Mah. Act No. VI of 2017) for the Amendment of R. 4439 relating to semester examination conducted of 3 years LLB Course and 5 years LLB Course from the academic year 2022-23. (The same is available on the University's website www.mu.ac.in) and to read as under:-

Amendment of R. 4439 relating to semester examination conducted of 3 years LL.B Course and 5 years LL.B Course.

Existing R.4439 :-

No candidate will be admitted to and allow to appear at the examinations to be conducted at the end of the Second, Fourth and Sixth Semester of 3 years LL.B. Course and of sixth. Eighth and Tenth semester of 5 years LL.B. Course unless he has successfully passed the examination in 'Practical Training Paper/s' for the respective semesters to be conducted by the respective colleges affiliated to the University of Mumbai on behalf of the University, with minimum of 40% of the marks.

Amended R.4439 :-

The mandatory requirement of passing the practical training and DPC papers in order to be eligible to appear in semesters 2,4 and 6 of LL B 3 yrs and semesters 6,8 and 10 LL B 5yrs shall be relaxed/deleted. The students will be eligible to appear in University semester end examinations of LL B 3 yrs Sem - 2,4 and 6 of and of LL B 5yrs Sem - 6, 8 and 10 even if they have failed or remained absent in the practical training and /or DPC courses. However the programme completion will require passing in all courses.
