#### **ABOUT THE UNIVERSITY:**

The Institute of Distance and Open Learning, IDOL, University of Mumbai, in collaboration with Society for Social Empowerment and Training, celebrated the International Women's Day on 8th of March, 2022 at the Kalina Campus. The Programme was the brainchild of Dr Prakash Mahanwar, Director IDOL. Dr. Santosh Rathod, Professor of English, and coordinated by Ms. Pankti Surve, Assistant Professor of Sociology. The special talk was presided over by Dr. Madhura Kulkarni, Deputy Director of IDOL.


With the vision to impart the need for gender equality amongst the staff,not only women, but even the male staff members participated in the programme. A talk was organized on the topic, "Empowering Women through Financial Security". Mr. Prashant Mathur, Ms. Radha Sule, Head Sustainability, TATA Capital, Ms. Deepali, Sr. Impact Manager, IDOBRO were the special invitees.

The Programme began at 11.30 am in the Seminar Hall of the Institute with the welcome speech of Dr. Santosh Rathod, followed by the Introduction of Ms. Radha Sule by Ms. Pankti Surve at the Institute. Ms. Radha, while addressing the audience, stressed on how finances today is not an area limited to the domain of men, but also, how important it is today for a woman too, to develop interest in managing finances. Ms. Deepali later conducted a session introducing "Dhan Gyan", which is a foundational course orienting the learners with basic concepts related to finances like Debentures, Mutual Funds, Stocks, ATM utility, SIPs and the importance of savings in future. The session was highly interactive. Both men and women took part in it.

The closing remarks were given by Mr. Prashant Mathur, CEO of SSET. In his words, "If a woman is provided with the required knowledge, and given a chance, she can prove herself and manage finances exceptionally well". Then, Dr. Madhura Kulkarni gave her presidential remarks stating the importance of financial management in the life of a woman and how being financially literate can play a major role in the life of not only a woman, but for the entire family. With all her motivation, she announced the beginning of a course on financial literacy which will have 9 modules, imparting knowledge on fundamentals of finances.

Dr. Naresh Tambe, Assistant Professor at the Department of Psychology, IDOL, proposed the Vote of Thanks where he expressed his gratitude for each one who has been a part of the programme . 





After each session interactive question answer session was held. Participants were actively responsive. The webinar was ended successfully with closing remark.


