ABOUT THE UNIVERSITY:

The University of Mumbai (known earlier as University of Bombay) is one of the oldest and premier Universities in India. It was established in 1857 and it is one amongst the first three Universities in India. As a sequel to the change in the name of the city from Bombay to Mumbai, the name of the University has been changed from "University of Bombay" to "University of Mumbai", vide notification issued by the Government of Maharashtra and published in the Government Gazette dated 4th September, 1996. The University was accorded 5 star status in 2001 & 'A' grade status in April 2012 by the National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC).

ABOUT INSTITUTE OF DISTANCE AND OPEN LEARNING:

In 1993 the Directorate of Distance Education was upgraded as the Institute of Distance Education. The institute is now renamed as Institute of Distance & Open Learning with effect from 13th February 2009. With this the Institute will be more open and flexible in its approach. Initially, the institute started with the meagre registration of 845 students which has grown up to a staggering figure of about 69,792 students in 2019-20. As on today 15 courses of IDOL have been recognised by UGC – DEB.

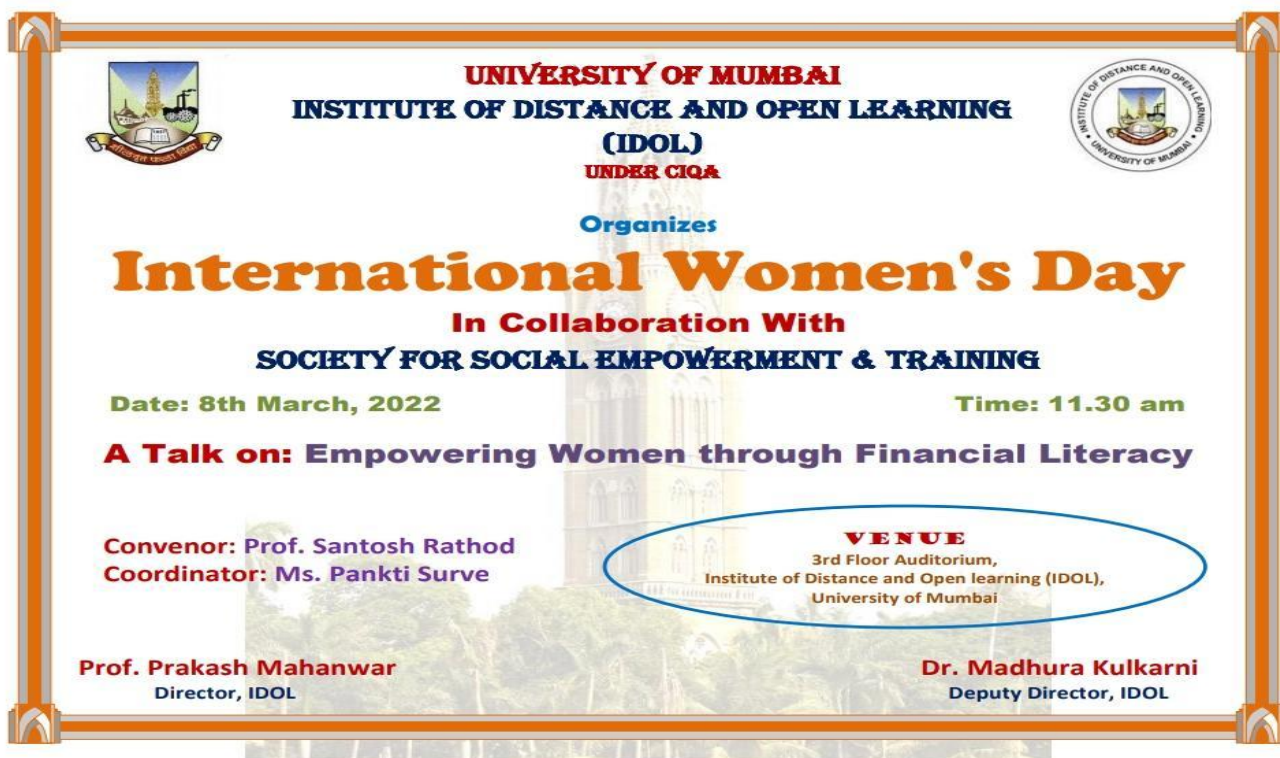

Ms. Radha, while addressing the audience, stressed on how finances today is not an area limited to the domain of men, but also, how important it is today for a woman too, to develop interest in managing finances. Ms. Deepali later conducted a session introducing "Dhan Gyan", which is a foundational course orienting the learners with basic concepts related to finances like Debentures, Mutual Funds, Stocks, ATM utility, SIPs and the importance of savings in future. In his words, "If a woman is provided with the required knowledge, and given a chance, she can prove herself and manage finances exceptionally well". With all her motivation, she announced the beginning of a course on financial literacy which will have 9 modules, imparting knowledge on fundamentals of finances.
