INSTRUCTION TO THE PROJECT WORK: -

- 1) The Examination shall commence from 10 a.m. everyday.
 - 2) Each group comprising of 4 to 5 candidates as formed by the College shall present the project work for 20 minutes (via Power Point) followed by 10 minutes defense.
 - 3) Each candidate of the group must give part of presentation during 20 minutes presentation assigned to the respective group.
 - 4) The total duration of exam conducted for 3 days for 60 intake and 4 days for 100 intake.
 - 5) Spiral bound copy of the Dissertation Book - a report (one per group) duly signed by guide and attested by Head of the Institute shall be present at the time of Examination.
 - 6) After completion of Examination within 2 days, external Examiner shall submit the Final Marks (out of 150) for each candidate jointly assigned by both Internal and External Examiners to the University.
- N.B.:** Candidates should bring their Identity Cards, Examination fee receipt and Certified Dissertation Book. Candidates who fail to present themselves at the time and appointed for their Practical or Oral examined practically or orally.

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Modes of Evaluation for Projects/Dissertation:

B. Pharm. Project:

This project is supervised or guided and need regular interaction (at least twice a week) with the supervisor/guide from the respective Institute. Project group must submit a joint project report (in Dissertation book) * and defend it in front of examiners. (*The complete details of the project have to be submitted as a Dissertation book of not less than 25 pages [A4, 1-inch margins, single line space, font Times Roman, font size 12] to the College before the prescribed date).

Evaluation of Project will be conducted by two examiners. One examiner shall be the internal examiner and the second examiner will be an External examiner who will be appointed by Mumbai University. The evaluation of examination shall be as follows:

A. Evaluation of Dissertation book (Project report):

Objective (s) of the work done	15 Marks
Methodology adopted	20 Marks
Results and Discussion	20 Marks
Conclusion and Outcomes	20 Marks
Total	75 Marks

The A part 75 marks assigned to the Dissertation book (project report) shall be same for all the students in a group.

B. Evaluation of Presentation:

Presentation quality of work	25 Marks
Communication Skills	20 Marks
Question and Answer skills	30 Marks
Total	75 Marks

The B part 75 marks assigned for presentation shall be awarded based on the performance of individual student in the given criteria.

Both the examiners shall jointly give marks out of 150 marks (6 Credit) assigned to the project for each candidate as sum of marks awarded in part A and B.

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
