From the Director's Desk



It's time to cheer up the happiest moment in the life of Institute of Distance and Open Learning (IDOL), for it has completed its 44th year in March 2014-15. Overthe years, IDOL has been known through different names like Directorate of Correspondence Course, Directorate of Distance Education, and till recently Institute of Distance Education. It started in 1971 with a chunk of 845 distance learners, and today, the IDOL has registered about 80,000 learners. When it began ,its office was located inone room at VVB then on one floor of the University of Mumbai Fort Campus, and now, it has it own building with Wi-Fi connectivity, Digital Indicator, LED display board at the entrance, kiosk machine, fully equipped library with air conditioned reading room ,classrooms, audiovisuals room etc.

There was a time when Distance Education (DE) used to be the last resort of all those who didn't get admission in regular colleges ,now the students prefer Distance Education as their first choice, especially in metropolis like Mumbai which offers umpteen employment opportunities. Also I would like to mention that from the last few years enrollment of woman in distance mode is increasing rapidly; and this year the figure touches 59% of total enrollment. That is our achievement in woman empowerment.

It gives me pleasure to share with you that we started with 2 programmes in 1971 and now we are having 14 programmes and 34 courses (Graduate, Post graduate and Diploma courses) most of them run with study materials prepared in Self Instructional Format. The learner support Services are spread over 74 Personal Contact Programme Centers across Mumbai and Konkan region .Apart from that, IDOL has its teaching faculties for different subjects who counsel the distance learners throughout the year. For the benefit of the students, we have started online process for admission, exam time table, exam admit card, exam dates, exam form submission etc. For more update IDOL is on social networking sites like Facebook. Twitter, Gmail accounts etc. And all the required details are uploaded on daily basis for the convenience of students. The IDOL students from different courses, standing in the merit ranks of the University of Mumbai, prove quality-facilities given to them. As a result our students bag the first rank in many examinations. And also I would like to add that a seventy one year old Miss Shroff Ketty Cyrus Najamai got the first rank in M.A (Avestha Pahlavi) in March-2014.Many of them have gone abroad for their further studies in UK, the USA ,Australia ,Canada, New Zealand etc. During the last five years, many well-known film personalities, journalists and many other honorable persons from various fields have also been enrolled in the IDOL.

During the last five years, we organized two international conferences on IDOL and a series of workshops on developing self-learning materials, workshop on Moodle, and two national level conferences in ODL. This year we also organized the National Round Table Conference of Directors of Distance Education Institutes in which 30 Directors were present to discuss about issues pertaining to ODL especially Distance Education Council of India (DECI) bill.

We have also become a member of ICDE and AAOU. I'm proud to be part of the team, and it gives me immense pleasure to be the head of this institute on 44th anniversary which falls during my tenure. It won't be overstatement to say that the IDOL has, in his history, witnessed of the distance education and suffering of distance learners in our country where they have to vie with the regular students at every step of life. I hope, the institute will be as asset and new facet to the university in near future.



Support Services

Study Material

The total number of books available in both English and Marathi are 309, of which there are 200 in English and 109 in Marathi. The materials are of best quality materials prepared in SLM format that is prescribed by DEC.

Online Admission

IDOL has started giving online admission so that student can seek admission from their home, office or anywhere which is convenient to the student. Not only that, IDOL has started giving exam hall tickets through online.

Wi-Fi Internet Connection

The institute premises is well-equipped with the Wi-Fi connectivity. One computer is also set up only for the students in the library.

Virtual Learning Centre

IDOL has initiated a number of programmes which are in the pipeline. We have started with EDUSAT programme with YCMOU, Nashik for UPSC and MPSC and EDUSAT for cartography (Geography) from ISRO, Bangalore. We have started online teaching and learning for various programmes like MA (Education), part II for ICT students, and B. Sc. (IT) Mathematics. It would be extended to other programmes.

Freeship/Scholarship

The institute has been providing freeship / scholarship facilities to the students belonging to the reserved category from the academic year 2007-2008. About 14-15 thousand students have taken benefit of these facilities.

We are giving admission to the reserved category students at only nominal fees. The poor and needy students are turning to IT Courses. Earlier due to financial problems they were not taking admission to these courses, but thanks to free ship/ scholarship, a number of students are taking admissions to these courses.

Institute and University Library Facility

The institute has an independent library having 46 thousand books including texts and references, and 30 research journals and periodicals. The institute provides fully airconditioned reading hall and book-lending facility. It remains open during office hours from 10.20am to 6.00pm and 8.00am to 8.00pm during examination time. Online catalogue of the books in the library are made available to the students through SOUL software.

Syllabus and Old Question Papers

For the reference, the institute provides old question papers and copies of syllabi are available on our website: www.mu.ac.in under the link, 'Revised Syllabus'.

Guidance and Counseling

The institute conducts PCP lectures at various centres located in Mumbai and suburban areas. The institute has also appointed its own teaching faculties for various subjects. At the headquarters, our teaching faculty regularly counsel the under graduate and post graduate students during the office hours.

Radio MUST: Community Radio

University of Mumbai has its community radio MUST (Mumbai University students talk) set at the frequency waves 107.8 FM. It is located at Justice Mahadeo Govind Ranade Bhavan, at Kalina campus. It broadcasts educational programmes.

MOODLE

IDOL is offering the ICT paper for MA (Education) part II fully online using the online learning management system MOODLE from 2011-12.

Consequently workshops on MOODLE were conducted to develop and design other courses on MOODLE.

Open Education Resources (OER).

In collaboration with Commonwealth of Learning (COL), the OER Project has been initiated by Hon'ble Vice Chancellor, Dr. Rajan Welukar. Presently F.Y.B. A. The institute has given photocopy facility to students and staff in our premises at a very low cost.
