#### From the Director's Desk



Which moment shall be more significant than the golden jubilee year in the life of the institution as well as the head of the institution? It is the proudest feeling I have today to write on this occasion. Institute of Distance and Open Learning, aka IDOL, University of Mumbai has been disseminating knowledge, upgrading the career options, and instrumental in nation building by imparting education through distance mode to all those who are cut off from 'time' (where there is no age limit) and 'place' (students can enroll from anywhere), at the same time it strikes balance between social,

economical, regional factors by providing equity in education, both continually and continuously.

Let's hark back to the philosophy of open and distance mode education in the world which set the first step of revolutionizing the education system. The first Open University in the world came into existence in the form of Open University in Milton Keynes in the United Kingdom in the year 1969. Just two years later in 1971, this IDOL was established as "Directorate of Correspondence Courses". It dropped its original name and assumed different names over the years as its functions kept on changing. IDOL was known by "Directorate of Distance Education", then "Institute of Distance Education" and now since 2009, it is known as "Institute of Distance and Open Learning".

IDOL's is a long journey of fifty years starting from 1971 to 2021 with a meager number of 845 students in 1971 to 70 thousand odd distance learners in 2021. This distance learning system started with a single table in a corner of a single room and now it stands sprawling over nearly 77000 sq feet area as Dr Shankar Dayal Sharma Bhavan on Vidyanagari campus of University of Mumbai. In addition, we have our four regional centres at Vidyapeeth Vidyarthi Bhavan Churchgate, Thane, Kalyan, and Ratnagiri, while the proposed Palghar Sub campus is under consideration. We offer UG, PG and Skill based certificate programmes through distance mode. We have online admission, examination and counseling sessions because of which our students are taking education beyond the state, national and international boundaries. IDOL has been a home of MOOCs, Eclipse and MOODLE as a part of the teaching learning process. Thus, I feel privileged to state that this very system of open and distance mode of higher education of University of Mumbai contributes to increasing GER (Gross Enrolment ratio) and Massification of Education.

The distance learners enrolled at IDOL do have the heterogeneous backgrounds based on gender, linguistic, regional, age, social and economic factors. The major traditional undergraduate and postgraduate courses from Arts, Science & Technology, Commerce and Interdisciplinary streams. IDOL has made all its Programmes in the Self Learning Materials in two mediums of instruction i.e. English and Marathi in the papers/courses other than languages and those of science and technology. They are made available in print format and soft copies are freely available for all on the official website so that anyone can use these SLM books as general reference. The counseling sessions are held at the various Learning Support Centres and sub-centers — some owned by the University of Mumbai while others are

maintained at the affiliating colleges of University of Mumbai. During the pandemic, IDOL has initiated the online counseling sessions for the students. Also, they are recorded and made available for the students for their asynchronous learning. Other facilities that IDOL provides with the distance learners which can be proudly stated here include free wifi facilities on campus, well stocked library with reading room facility equipped with AC and computers at headquarters. LED display board and Psychological Counseling centre, gym for students and staff with different schedules for male and female set up at the entrance of Dr Shanakar Dayal Bhavan at Vidyanagari campus call for a special mention.

Two full time faculty members for each subject, one full time Professor grade Director, one full time Deputy Director (Academic), one full time Assistant Director (Academic), one full time Deputy Registrar for Public Relation Office as a part of Student Support Services in ODL have been the striking features of Institute of Distance and Open Learning. In the administrative wing, IDOL does have officers ranging from Deputy Registrars through Assistants Registrar, Superintendent, Head Clerk, Sr. Clerk, Jr. Clerk to Hamal and Peon. Other than the full time permanent administrative staff there has been nearly 170 seasonal but full time staff.

We are constantly in touch with the students through Website, Twitter, Facebook, YouTube Channel, Telegram etc. to name a few. What's unique is the Public Relation Office of the IDOL headed by Deputy Registrar Public Relation Office which constantly works as a Liaison between IDOL Office and students, IDOL Office and media, IDOL Office and general public for updating about what's new in the IDOL.

Several of IDOL students top the University examinations and bag the Gold, the Silver and the Bronze medals. Few cracked competitive exams like UPSC, MPSc and UGC NET and SET examinations. Many have completed PhDs./M. Phils and are pursuing PhDs./M. Phils. Many IDOL students find a place in Foreign Universities from the UK, The USA, Canada, Australia and NewZealand to name a few. Many IDOL students are reputed personalities in the field of Media and Politics.

There is a Paradigm shift from Distance and Open Learning to Open and Online Learning and IDOL is taking baby steps towards that direction ensuring the quality education and equity to all the learners. I am sure that IDOL over the years is an asset and facet of the University of Mumbai.

#### 1. About University of Mumbai

The University of Mumbai, one of the oldest and premier universities in India, was established on 18<sup>th</sup> July, 1857. It is one amongst the first three universities in Indian giving higher education to the Indians. The University of Mumbai has been Potential for Excellence Award by the University Grants Commission. Since its inception, the IDOL has been offering various traditional degrees, technical and professional courses through distance mode. The IDOL is now member of ICDE and AAOU.





#### SUPPORT SERVICES

#### **Study Material**

The total number of books available in both English and Marathi are 369, of which there are 289in English and 165 in Marathi. The materials are of best quality materials prepared in SLM format that is prescribed by DEC.

#### **Online Admissions**

IDOL has started giving online admission so that student can seek admission from their home, office or anywhere which is convenient to the student. Not only that, IDOL has started giving exam hall tickets through online.

#### **Virtual Learning Class Room**

IDOL has initiated a number of programmes which are in the pipeline. We have started with EDUSAT programme with YCMOU. Nashik for UPSC and MPSC and EDUSAT for cartography (Geography) form ISRO, Banglore. We have started online teaching and learning for various programmes like MA (Education) Part – II ICT students and B.Sc. (IT) Mathematics. It would be extended to other programmes.

#### **Scholarship Facilities**

The institute has been providing scholarship facilities to the students belonging to the reserved category from the academic year 2007-2008. About 14-15 thousand students have taken benefit of these facilities.

We are giving admission to the reserved category students at only nominal fees. The poor and needy students are turning to the IT courses. Earlier due to financial problems they were not taking admission to these courses, but thanks to freeship / scholarship, a number of students are taking admissions to these courses.

#### **Institute and University Library Facility**

The institute has an independent library having 49,293 books including texts and references, and 2 research journals, periodicals. The institute provides fully airconditioned reading hall and the book-lending facility. It remains open during office hours i.e. from 10:20 a.m. to 06.00 p.m. and 8.00 a.m. to 8.00 pm during examination time. Online catalogue of the books in the library are made available to the students through SOUL software.
