Academy of Theatre Arts - Academy of theatre arts has taken a long stride at national and international level within twenty years. It has become one of the the leading theatre training institutes in India. This institute was established in 2003. \University of mumbai initiated its academy keeping in mind the dearth of theatre training institutes in mumbai, despite the city being the main centre of theatre activity in the country. Academy of theatre arts offers a full time comprehensive master degree course in theatre arts. Apart from the various subjects, the students also do a scene work and three full length productions under eminent directors. The students are given ample opportunities to watch and study and interact with theatre personalities, performances and seminars thereby exposing them to current theatre practices. The students of the academy have themselves directed and presented more than 250 class room presentations till date. The Academy also organises its own National Theatre Festival 'Rashtriya Vasant Natyotsav' every year.

Aims, Objectives & Outcomes

- Aims The master of performing arts (theatre) programme will assist students in developing the skills necessary to design, plan, create, implement, manage, and market their creative works, such as drama, film, short films and other performing art forms. Students will explore the scope of the entertainment industry, learn how to effectively manage various performing art forms and evaluate their outcomes.
- Objectives- 1) To provide intensive theoretical and practical knowledge of theatre and performing arts. 2) To provide integrated perspective of management functioning along with a fair amount of exposure real life cases / technical know how. 3)To impact understanding of the stage of theatre and entertainment industry. 4) To learn to how to manage time effectively, To manage Human Resources and volunteers.

• Outcomes-

- 1) Creates an additional avenue of self employment for the students of university of Mumbai, it will also benefit the cultural field by providing with suitable trained professionals in the field of theatre arts and dramatics.
- 2) students will explore opportunities in the field of performing arts, mass communication, film, electronic media and administration.
- 1. Students will have adequate professional understanding about acting, production, and direction.

And Entrance exam / interview / audition.

duration of the course & related information

- The course is full time course. The duration of the course is two years. Each batch consists of not more than 30 students.
- No student will be allowed to complete this course or appear for examinations as an external candidate. 90% attendance is compulsory to be eligible for exams.
- Candidate should have knowledge of English, Hindi and Marathi. These languages are flexibly used for teaching and performance.

syllabus

The syllabus of the Academy of theatre arts is broadly based and carefully designed. The uniqueness of the syllabus is that theory is always linked with practical work. The weightage given to theory and practical is 40% and 60% respectively. The course is integrated in nature. However the main thrust is on participation in the production process itself. 



The whole exercise is designed of a single rope with the pracitioner suspended in mid-air.







He is an author of, "Nishaani Dava Angtha" (a play) & 'Mee Yenarya Peedheechee Deesha Gheun Phirtoy' (a poetry). He has translated Om Prakash Walmiki's autobiography 'Joothan' as 'Ushta' in Marathi. For last 20 years Dr. Mangesh Bansod is regularly a writing poems, articles & criticisms for prestigious newspapers, literature magazines in Maharashtra. 
