Abstract

Digambara Jaina Ācārya Kundakunda and Ādi Śaṅkarācārya are mystic philosophers whose writings satisfy not only the brain but also the heart. Kundakunda highlights the important Jaina tenets and brings in his own terminology of niścaya and vyavahāra naya which is comparable to the concept of sattā as found in Śaṅkarā's writings. The present talk will focus on some of the key issues and will enable us to revisit and dwell deep into these philosophies.
