ABOUT CORNELIA SORABJEE

Cornelia Sorabjee (1866-1954) was the first woman to graduate from the University of Bombay, and the first woman and the first Indian to read for the Bachelor of Civil Law in Oxford. She was the first female advocate in India and she was also the first woman to practice Law in Britain. She was a legal advisor to women and children on matters in provincial courts, and as a 'Lady Assistant' to the Court of Wards for several years before she qualified as a barrister, when women were admitted to the profession for the first time in 1923. In addition to her work as an advocate for women and children, she became an advocate of social reform, campaigning in particular for the education for girls, legal rights for women subject to segregation (purdahnashins), abolition of child marriage, and protection and support for widows.
