## Department of Philosophy Ordinances & Regulations

<u>Title of the Course</u>:- One year Part Time Advance Diploma Course in Philosophy of Vallabha Vedanta (Shuddhavaita) & Vaisnavism 1) Eligibility: A candidate for being eligible for admission to Advance Diploma Course in Vallabha Vedanta & Vaisnavism must have passed the Diploma Course in Vallabha Vedanta & Vaisnavism conducted by the Department of Philosophy, University of Mumbai (or an equivalent Diploma Course in Vallabha Vedanta from any other University as for example Saurashtra University).

2) <u>Duration</u>: Advance Diploma Course in Vallabha Vedanta is a part time course and its duration shall be one year consisting of two

3) Papers: There are two papers for each of which one and half lectures will be held per week. The total number of lectures per week is 3 hours.

#### 4) Examination:

- a) Eligibility: A candidate for being eligible for admission to the examination shall satisfy the following requirements:-
  - 1) He/she shall have attended the course of instruction for at least three-fourths of hours of instructions during each term
  - 2) He/she shall produce a certificate from the Course Coordinator stating that he/ she be permitted to appear for the examination.
- b) Evaluation Pattern:
- 1) There will be two examinations of 100 marks each for paper I & paper II
- 2) There will be only One Project of 50 marks
- 3) The total number of marks at the examination is 250.
- 4) The minimum number of pass marks is 40 in each 100 mark paper.
- The minimum number of pass marks required for passing project of 50 marks is 20.

### Preamble

## Advance Diploma Course in The Philosophy of Vallabha Vedanta (Suddhadvaita) and Vaisnavism

Vallabha Vedanta Academy & Research Centre, under Philosophy Department, University of Mumbai was established in 2005-2006. Since then the number of students enrolled for Certificate Course and Diploma Course has been very encouraging. For Certificate Course, we had 106 students (2005-2006), 80 (2006-2007), 86 (2007-2008) and 66 (2008-2009) & for Diploma Course the number was 98 (2006-2007), 55 (2007-2008) and 58 (2008-2009).

Now in continuation with the Certificate & Diploma Courses in Vallabha Vedanta and Vaisnavism, the Department of Philosophy wishes to introduce an Advance Diploma Course in Vallabha Vedanta and Vaisnavism. In Advance Diploma Course, the students will study Vallabha Vedanta/Suddhadvaita Philosophy of Sri Vallabhacarya with reference to the four Major Texts written by Sri Vallabha Himself (of which two are the commentaries on Brahma Sutras and on Bhagavata, & the other two are His independent works). Such study will enable students to undertake deeper research work. Further, the students themselves have expressed their keen desire to participate in such a course. Hence, such a course will only be an academic asset to deepen the existing study and research in Vedanta and Vaisnavism at the Department.

There will be two papers for Advance Diploma Course in Philosophy of Vallabha Vedanta & Vaisnavism, each carrying 100 marks and One Project of 50 marks, i.e. total marks 250.
