Science and Commerce and the Director, Institute of Distance Education is hereby invited to the Ordinances and Regulations relating to the B.A., B.Sc. and B.Com. degree courses vide pamphlet Nos. 135.136. 137 and office Circular Nos.UG./178 of 1998 dated 29th May, 1998 No.UG/92 of 1999 dated 4th March, 1999 and No.UG./171 of 1998 dated 6th May, 1998 and hereby informed that as per resolution passed by the Academic Council at its meeting held on 6th August, 2003 vide item No.4.32 and subsequently approved by Management Council at its meeting held on 16th August, 2003 vide item No.21 and that in accordance therewith the Ordinances 2138, 2145 and 2152 relating to the eligibility criteria for admission to the Three Year course leading to the B.A., B.Sc. and B.Com. degree courses by adding the subject of Information Technology among the subjects under serial No.2 respectively has been amended to read as under:

FIRST YEAR B.A.

O.2138: A candidate for being eligible for admission to the three year integrated course leading to the degree of Bachelor of Arts must have passed the Higher Secondary School Certificate (Std.XII) examination conducted by the different Divisional Boards of the Maharashtra State Board of Secondary and Higher Secondary Education with the following subjects:

- 1. English
- 2. Any one of the Modern Indian Languages or Modern Foreign Languages or any Classical Language or Information Technology.
- 3. Any four subjects carrying 100 marks each.

Must have passed the Higher Secondary School Certificate (Std.XII) examination with Vocational subjects conducted by the different Divisional Boards of the Maharashtra State Board of Secondary and Higher Secondary Education, with the following subjects:-

- 1. English
- 2. Any one Vocational subjects carrying 200 marks prethe Board from time to time.
- 3. Any three subjects carrying 100 marks each

Must have passed the Higher Secondary School Certificate (Std.) examination with the Minimum Competency based vocational courses conducted by the different Divisional Boards of the Maharashtra State Board of Secondary and Higher Secondary Education, with the following subjects :-

- English (Higher Level or Lower Level)
- Any one of the Modern Indian Languages, or Modern Foreig 2. Languages or any Classical Language (Higher Level or Lowe Level) or Information Technology.
