CIRCULAR :

A reference is invited to the Ordinances, Regulations and Syllabi relating to the Bachelor of Architecture (B.Arch.) degree course vide Pamphlet No.165 and to this office Circular No.UG/103 of 2001 dated 28th March, 2001 and Principals of the affiliated colleges in Architecture are hereby informed that the recommendation made by the Ad-hoc Board of Studies in Architecture at its meeting held on 11th March, 2004 has been accepted by the Academic Council at its meeting held on 2nd April, 2004 vide item No. 452 and that in accordance therewith, the candidates who have not been granted term of Semester VIII under B.Arch. degree (Old) course will be considered eligible for admission to the Fourth Year of the B.Arch.(Revised) degree course subject to the condition that they should pass Landscape subject as per the syllabus prescribed for the Third Year of the B.Arch. degree course, without keeping terms as a special case. However, the results of such candidates at the Fourth Year examination shall not be declared unless they have passed Landscape subject of the Third Year examination.

Further that the above recommendation has been brought into force with effect from the examinations to be held in the first half of 2004.
