Sir,

I am to invite your attention to the Ordinances, Regulations and Syllabi relating to the examinations leading to the Bachelor of Chemical Engineering (B.Chem.Engg.) degree course vide Pamphlet No.205 and to this office Circular No.UG/453 of 1999 dated 21st August, 1999 and to inform you that the recommendation made by the Board of Studies in Chemical Technology at its meeting held on 9th July, 20004 has been accepted by the Academic Council at its meeting held on 7th August, 2004 vide item No.4.6 which has subsequently been approved by the Management Council at its meeting held on 13th August 2004 vide item No.6 in exercise of the powers conferred upon it under Sub Section (i) of section 55 of the Maharashtra Universities Act 1994, and that in accordance therewith the following R.4839 relating to the Final Year (Semester I & II) examinations of the B.Chem Engineering degree course has been passed and incorporated in the Ordinances and Regulations relating to the B.Chem. Engineering degree Course :-

R.4839 : Candidates who have passed the Bachelor of Chemical Engineering Degree examination and who wish to improve their class or percentage of marks be permitted to appear again for the Final Year Semester I & Semester II examinations conducted by the University with the same subject (all subjects of Semester-I & Semester-II theory and practical together) without being required to keep any term again. This provision shall be made applicable at the subsequent examination, but not more than at five consecutive examinations conducted by the University. The marks obtained by the candidate in Seminar/Project Term Work/Class Work/Periodic Test shall be carried forward for these consecutive examinations. However, such candidates have to appear for the examinations with all subject heads at appropriate time in single attempt only.

Further that Regulation 4839 has been brought into force with effect from the academic year 2004-2005.
