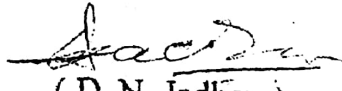

Com. degree course vide Circular No. UG/227 of 2009 dated 16th June, 2009 and the Principals of the affiliated colleges in Commerce and Professor-cum-Director, Institute of Distance & Open Learning are hereby informed that the recommendation made by the Board of Studies in English at its meeting held on Friday 6th November, 2009 has been accepted by the Academic Council at its meeting held on 20th November, 2009 vide Item No.4.9 and that, in accordance therewith, the following changes have been introduced in the tutorial testing in the subject of Business Communication for F.Y.B.Com. from the year 2009-2010.

New pattern for tutorial testing

- Each Term-End Examination will be of 40 marks.
- Tutorials will be of 20 marks.
- Tutorials will be tested term-wise, allocating 10 marks per term.
- A student will have to secure a minimum of 7 marks out of 20 in tutorials. (A student failing to submit tutorial in the I term will be allowed to take the First-Term-End examination)
- A student failing to secure the required minimum 7 marks (out of 20) in tutorials will not be allowed to appear for the II Term-End examination.
- Passing Criteria : Theory Examination (80 Marks)
Tutorial Testing (20 Marks)
Theory and Tutorials are separate heads of passing.

Minimum Pass Marks:	Theory	28 out of 80
	Tutorial	7 out of 20
	Total	35 out of 100

- **Old pattern for testing :**
- Each Term End Examination will be of 40 marks.
- Tutorials: 20 Marks—Which could be tested term-wise, allocating 10 marks each.
- A student failing to submit the tutorial will not be allowed to appear for the examination.
- Theory Examination (80 Marks)
- Tutorial Testing (20 Marks)

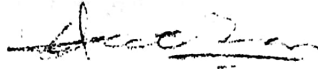

A reference is invited to the Ordinances, Regulations and syllabi relating to the minimum attendance necessary for keeping terms and condonation of deficiency in attendance vide this office circular No.UG/502 of 1999, dated 6th October, 1999 and the Dean of the J.J. Institute of Applied Art and the Dean of the J.J. School of Art are hereby informed that the recommendation made by the Faculty of Fine Art at its meeting held on Tuesday, 10th November, 2009 has been accepted by the Academic Council at its meeting held on 20th November, 2009 vide item No.4.14 and subsequently approved by the Management Council at its meeting held on 26th November, 2009 vide item No.21 and that, in accordance therewith, in exercise of the powers conferred upon the Management Council under Section 54(1) of the Maharashtra Universities Act, 1994, it has amended O.119 relating to the minimum attendance necessary for keeping terms to be read as under:-

O.119: The following shall be the minimum attendance necessary for keeping terms:-

<u>Faculty</u>	<u>First Term</u>	<u>Second Term</u>
Ayurvedic Medicine	75 percent of the total number of lectures and practicals held in a term.	
Dentistry	75 percent attendance of lectures, practicals Clinics, demonstrations and seminars held in the two terms taken together at each of the examinations leading to the B.D.S. and M.D.S.	
Medicine (only for First, for First, Second and Third M.B.B.S. Examinations)	75 percent of the total number of lectures delivered and 75 percent of the total number of practicals held during the three terms taken together.	
Arts*, Science, Commerce, Law, Technology and <u>Fine Art</u>	For granting the terms in each subject minimum attendance of 75% of the theory, lectures, practicals & tutorials (wherever prescribed) separately will be required out of the total numbers of lectures, practicals and Tutorials in the subject conducted in the term.	

Notwithstanding what is stated above, students participating in sports, cultural activities, N.C.C., N.S.S., Adult and Continuing Education and Extension will be permitted full credit for lectures/practicals/tutorials missed by them as a result of their participation in N.C.C., N.S.S., A.C.E.E. camps, Inter-collegiate, Inter-University, State National and Inter-national tournaments/competitions and coaching camps/training sessions organized in preparation of these tournaments/competitions. This credit should be allowed on the basis of Production of certificate of participation in such authorized activity from the concerned organizers.

* For the B.S.W. and M.S.W. degree course under the Faculty of Arts, three fourths of the lectures held for each subject in each term has been laid down.

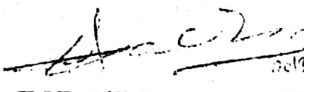
