

CIRCULAR :-

A reference is invited to the Ordinances, Regulations and syllabi relating to the degree course (full time) vide Pamphlet No.203 and to this office Circular No.UG/312 of 1997 dated 5th September, 1997 and No.UG/148 of 2005, dated 26th April, 2005 and the Principals of the affiliated colleges in Engineering are hereby informed that the recommendation made by the Faculty of Technology at its meeting held on September, 2008 has been accepted by the Academic Council at its meeting held on September, 2008 vide item No.4.14 and subsequently approved by the Management Council at its meeting held on 4th October, 2008 vide item No.4 and that, in accordance therewith, in exercise of the powers conferred upon the Management Council under Section 54(1) of the Maharashtra Universities Act 1994, it has amended Ordinances No. 3706, 3709, 3711, 3721, 3723, 3725, 3727, 3729 and 3731 relating to the B.E. (full time) degree course to read as under :-

Ordinances relating to the Admission

0.3706 : A candidate who has passed Semester I and Semester II examinations will be permitted to enter upon the course for Semester III. However, a candidate who has failed in not more than 5 heads of passing of Semester I and Semester II examinations considered together will also be permitted to enter upon the course for Semester III.

0.3709 : A candidate who has passed Semester I to Semester IV examinations will be permitted to enter upon the course for Semester V. However, a candidate who has failed in not more than 5 heads of passing of Semester III and Semester IV examinations considered together will also be permitted to enter upon the course for Semester V provided he/she has passed Semester I and Semester II examinations.

0.3711 : A candidate who has passed Semester I to Semester VI examinations will be permitted to enter upon the course for Semester VII. However, a candidate who has failed in not more than 5 heads of passing of Semester V and Semester VI examinations considered together will also be permitted to enter upon the course for Semester VII provided he/she has passed Semester I to Semester IV examinations.

Ordinances relating to the Appearance

0.3721 : A candidate for being eligible to appear for Semester III of the Second Year Engineering Examination should have satisfactorily kept the term for Semester III and passed in Semester I and Semester II examinations. However, a candidate who has failed in not more than 5 heads of passing of Semester I and Semester II examinations considered together will also be permitted to appear for Semester III examination.

0.3723 : A candidate for being eligible to appear for Semester IV of the Second Year Engineering Examination should have satisfactorily kept the term for Semester IV. However, a candidate who has failed in not more than 5 heads of passing in Semesters I and Semester II examinations taken together and who has satisfactorily kept the terms for Semesters III and IV, will also be permitted to appear for Semester IV examination.

O.3725 : A candidate for being eligible to appear for Semester V of the Third Year Engineering Examination should have satisfactorily kept the term for Semester V and passed all examination up to Semester IV. However, a candidate who has failed in not more than **5 heads** of passing of Semester IV and Semester IV examinations considered together will also be permitted to appear for Semester V examination.

O.3727 : A candidate for being eligible to appear for Semester VI of the Third Year Engineering Examination should have satisfactorily kept the term for Semester VI. However, a candidate who has failed in not more than **5 heads** of passing in Semester III and Semester IV examinations taken together and who has satisfactorily kept the terms for Semester V and VI will also be permitted to appear for Semester VI examination.

O.3729 : A candidate for being eligible to appear for Semester VII of the Final Year Engineering Examination should have satisfactorily kept the term for Semester VII and passed all examinations up to Semester VI. However, a candidate who has failed in not more than **5 heads** of passing of Semester V and Semester VI examinations considered together will also be permitted to appear for Semester VII examination.

O.3731 : A candidate for being eligible to appear for Semester VIII of the Final Year Engineering Examination should have satisfactorily kept the term for Semester VIII. However, a candidate who has failed in not more than **5 heads** of passing in Semester V and Semester VI examinations taken together and who has satisfactorily kept the terms for Semesters VII and VIII will also be permitted to appear for Semester VIII examination.

Further that the amended Ordinances 3706, 3709, 3711, 3721, 3723, 3725, 3729 and 3731 relating to the B. E. (Full-time) (all branches) degree course have been brought into force with effect from the academic year 2008-2009.

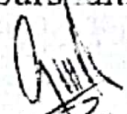
