CIRCULAR:

A reference is invited to the Ordinances, Regulations and syllabi relating to the Bachelor of Education (B.Ed) degree course vide this office Circular No. UG/ 93 of 2003 dated 4th March, 2003 and the Principals of affiliated Training Colleges in Education are hereby informed that the recommendation made by the Board of studies in Education at its meeting held on 28th March, 2008 has been accepted by the Academic Council at its meeting held on 15th April, 2008 vide item No. 4.54 and subsequently approved by the Management Council at its meeting held on 24th April, 2008 vide item No. 16 and that, in accordance therewith, in exercise of the powers conferred upon the Management Council under Section 55(1) of the Maharashtra Universities Act 1994, it has amended Regulations 4253, 4254 and 4257 relating to Theory – External Assessment, Practicum – Internal Assessment and Grade and Corresponding Grade points respectively at the B-Ed degree course and that the same has been brought into force with effect from the academic year 2008-2009 :-

The Principal of the Institution in which the candidate is studying will be required to keep a record of all the work done in the College and Practicing School/Junior College and Certify, that the work has been completed satisfactorily.

Degree Courses to read as under. :-

R.4129 :- Marks up to maximum of 50(fifty) shall be assigned by the Head of the Chemical Engineering Division in the subject head "Seminar" and reported to the Controller of the Examinations by the Director of the Institute before the Commencement of the examination. Marks obtained by the candidate in the subject head "Seminar" shall be carried over to subsequent examination, unless fresh marks are submitted. Candidates whose marks are thus carried over shall be eligible for a class.

The candidate who fails to clear "Seminar" in the Second Semester of the course be permitted to complete the "Seminar" in the following Semester/s, with a new Seminar topic. Provided further that the Marks obtained for the Seminar will be considered alongwith the result of the regular Semester examination in which the Seminar is cleared.

R.4151 : For the semester II marks up to a maximum of 100 shall be assigned by the Heads of Division in the subject head "Seminar" and reported to the Controller of Examination by the Director of the Institute before the commencement of the examination. Marks obtained by candidates in the subject head "Seminar" shall be carried over to subsequent examination unless fresh marks are submitted. Candidates whose marks are thus carried over shall be eligible for a class.

The candidate who fails to clear "Seminar" in the second semester of the course be permitted to complete the "Seminar" in the following semester/s, with a new seminar topic. Provided further that the Marks obtained for the Seminar will be considered along with the result of the regular semester examination in which the Seminar is cleared.

R.4193 : For the semester II examination, marks up to a maximum of 50 (fifty) shall be assigned by the Heads of Laboratories in the subject head "Seminar" and reported to the Controller of Examinations by the Director of the Institute before the commencement of the examination.

Marks obtained by the candidates in the subject head "Seminar" shall be carried over to subsequent examination unless fresh marks are submitted. Candidates whose marks are thus carried over shall be eligible for the class.

The candidate who fails to clear "Seminar" in the second semester of the course be permitted to complete the "Seminar" in the following Semester/s, with a new Seminar topic. Provided further that the candidate obtained for the seminar will be considered along with the result of the next semester examination in which the Seminar is cleared.
