I am to invite your attention to the scheme of papers relating to the degree of Bachelor of Performing Art (B.P.A.) in Music and to this office Circular No.UG/157 of 2000 dated 10th May, 2000 and to inform you that the following recommendations made by the Ad-hoc Board of Studies in Hindustani Music at its meeting held on 10th December 2003 has been accepted by the Academic Council at its meeting held on 2nd April, 2004 vide Item No. 4.45 and subsequently approved by the Maril 2004 (vide approved by the Management Council at its meeting held on 17th April, 2004 (vide elaibility and that in accordance therewith the Ordinance 4006 relating to the eligibility criteria for admission to the Bachelor of Performing Art (B.P.A.) in Music is amended to read as under:-

O. 4006: A candidate for being eligible for admission to the degree of Bacheles of Performing Art (B.P.A.) (Music) must have passed the H.S.C. (Std.XII) examination conducted by the Maharashtra State Board of Higher Secondary Education or an examination of another body recognized as equivalent thereto and passed the Diploma in Music of the University or the Salgeet Madhyam Poorna from the Akhil Bharativa Gandharva Mahavidyalaya Mandal, Mumbai . The candidate's admission to the course will be subject to his/her passing an audition test conducted by the Head of the Institution where the candidate seeks admission. The candidates who have passed the Diploma in Music examination of University of Mumbai in 'A' Grade or above are exempted from this audition test. '.

Further that the amended Ordinance 4006 will be brought into force with effect from the academic year 2004-2005.
