

CIRCULAR :

Attention of the Director, Mumbai University Institute of Chemical Technology and the Principals of the affiliated colleges in Pharmacy is hereby invited to the Ordinances, Regulations and Syllabi relating to the Bachelor of Pharmaceutical Sciences (B.Pharm. Science) degree course vide Pamphlet No.187 and to this office Circular No.UG 451 of 2003 dated 17th September,2003 and they are hereby informed that the recommendation made by the Ad-hoc Board of Studies in Pharmaceutical Sciences at its meeting held on 25th May,2005 has been accepted by the Academic Council at its meeting held on 14th June,2005 vide Item No. 4.11 and subsequently approved by the Management Council at its meeting held on 18th June,2005 vide Item No.4 and that in accordance therewith Regulation 4384 relating to the B.Pharm. Sciences degree (Revised Course) has been amended to reads as under :-

R.4384 :-Candidates who remain absent for the examinations periodic tests-

If a candidate does not appear for the examination in one or more subjects/heads in which the candidate's form is accepted for the examination, the candidate will be declared as failed and is not eligible for ATKT (see under ATKT rules above). If a candidate having ATKT remains absent in the subsequent examinations the ATKT continues. If the candidate remains absent for the periodic tests, the candidate will be declared as failed/ATKT, as the case may be.

Further that the amended Regulation 4384 relating to the B.Pharm. Sciences degree (Revised Course) has been brought into force with effect from the examination held in first half of 2005.
