

CIRCULAR :-

A reference is invited to the Ordinances, Regulations and syllabi relating to the Bachelor of Pharmacy (B.Pharm.) degree course vide Pamphlet. No. 187 and to this office circular No. UG/175 of 2007 dated 3rd May, 2007 and the Director, Mumbai University Institute of Pharmacy and the Principals of the Pharmacy colleges are hereby informed that the recommendation made by the Ad-hoc Board of Studies in Pharmacy at its meeting held on 16th February, 2008 has been accepted by the Academic Council at its meeting held on 27th February, 2008 vide item No. 4.40 and subsequently approved by the Management Council at its meeting held on 24th April, 2008 vide item No. 15 and that, in accordance therewith, in exercise of the powers conferred upon the Management Council under Section 54 (1) of the Maharashtra Universities Act 1994, it has made Ordinance 5695 relating to the eligibility criteria for admission at the entry level at Semester I into the course of the B.Pharm. degree course is amended to read as under :-

O.5695 :- Eligibility criteria for admission to candidate of Pharmacy at the entry level at Semester I of the course.

Eligibility criteria for Maharashtra State candidate and Outside Maharashtra State candidate for admission to First Year degree course in Pharmacy :-

Candidate should be an Indian National and should have passed the HSC (Std.XII) examination of Maharashtra State Board of Secondary and Higher Secondary Education or its equivalent examination with subject English, Physics, Chemistry and Biology/Mathematics AND secured minimum 50% marks i.e. not less than 150 marks out of 300 marks (minimum 45% marks i.e. not less than 135 marks out of 300 marks in case of candidates of Backward Class categories belonging only to Maharashtra State) in the subjects Physics, Chemistry and Biology/Mathematics added together (Maximum of marks obtained in Biology/Mathematics shall be considered for the purpose of addition) AND obtained a non zero score at MHT-CET and as per the norms laid down by the Government from time to time.

Eligibility criteria of candidates who have passed/passing Diploma in Pharmacy and seeking admission to First Year of Pharmacy :-

Diploma holders who have passed the Diploma Course in Pharmacy with minimum of 50% marks and medium of instruction as English from the Polytechnics affiliated to MSBTE or AICTE approved autonomous polytechnics in Maharashtra State (for Maharashtra State Candidates) or such Polytechnics situate inside/outside the State of Maharashtra (for outside Maharashtra State candidates).

Further that amended Ordinance 5695 relating to the eligibility criteria for admission at the entry level at Semester I has been brought into force with effect from the academic year 2008 - 2009.
