CIRCULAR

A reference is invited to the Ordinances of the Bachelor of Science in Information Technology (B.Sc. I.T.) (Three Year Degree Course) vide Pamphlet No.338 and to this office Circular No.UG/469 of 2003 dated 20th September, 2003 and the Principals of the affiliated colleges in the Faculty of Arts, Science and Commerce are hereby informed that the recommendation made by the ad-hoc Committee at its meeting held on 25th September, 2003 has been accepted by the Academic Council at its meeting held on 3rd January, 2004 vide item No.4.2 and has been subsequently approved by the Management Council at its meeting held on 28th January, 2004 vide item No.22 and that in accordance therewith 'at one and the same sitting' be deleted from the eligibility criteria prescribed for admission to the B.Sc.(Information Technology) degree course under O.5051.

They are further informed that in exercise of the powers conferred upon the Management Council sub section (I) of Section 54 of the Maharashtra Universities Act, 1994 the Management Council has amended the Ordinance 5051 relating to the eligibility criteria prescribed for admission to the B.Sc.(I.T.) degree course.

The text of the amended Ordinance 5051 reads as under :-

"O.5051: A candidate for being eligible for admission to the degree course of Bachelor of Science - Information Technology, shall have passed XII Standard examination of the Maharashtra State Board of Secondary and Higher Secondary Education or its equivalent with Mathematics as one of the subjects and should have secured not less than 45% marks in aggregate and 40% marks in aggregate in case of reserved category candidates.

OR

Candidates who have passed Diploma in Computer Engineering/Computer Science/Computer Technology/Information Technology/Electrical, Electronics/ Allied branches, Mechanical and Allied branches, Civil and Allied branches of Engineering are eligible for admission to the First Year of the B.Sc.(I.T.) degree course. However, the Diploma should be recognized by the Maharashtra State Board of Technical Education or any other recognised Government body. Minimum marks required 45% aggregate for open category candidates and 40% aggregate for reserved category candidates.

Further that the amended Ordinance 5051 will be brought into force with effect from the academic year 2004-2005.
