

CIRCULAR:-

A reference is invited to the Ordinances of the Bachelor of Science in Information Technology (B.Sc. I.T.) (Three Year Degree Course) vide Pamphlet No.338 and to this office Circular No.UG/47 of 2004, dated 23rd February, 2004 and the Co-Ordinator, University Department of Information Technology, University of Mumbai and the Principals of the affiliated college in Faculty of Arts, Science and Commerce are hereby informed that the proposal for amendment of O.5051 relating to the B.Sc.(I.T.) degree course has been accepted by the Academic Council at its meeting held on 18th June, 2004 vide item No.4.31 and subsequently approved by the Management Council at its meeting held on 31st July, 2004 (vide Item No.17) and that in accordance therewith O.5051 relating to the B.Sc.(Information Technology) degree course prescribed eligibility criteria for admission to the course has been amended to read as under :-

"O.5051 :- A candidate for being eligible for admission to the degree course of Bachelor of Science -Information Technology, shall have passed XII Standard examination of the Maharashtra Board of Higher Secondary Education or its equivalent with Mathematic as one of the subject and should have secured not less than 45% marks in aggregate for Open Category and 40% marks in aggregate in case of Reserved category candidates.

AND

Candidate who have passed Diploma in Computer Engineering/ Computer Science/Computer Technology/Information Technology/Electrical, Electronics & Video Engineering and Allied branches/Mechanical and Allied branches, Civil and Allied branches of Engineering after S.S.C.(Xth Standard) are eligible for direct admission to the Second Year of the B.Sc.(I.T.) degree course.

However, the Diploma should be recognized by the Board of Technical Education or any other recognized Government Body. Minimum marks required 45% aggregate for Open Category candidate and 40% aggregate for Reserved candidates.

OR

Candidates with post HSC-Diploma in Computer Engineering/ Computer Science/Computer Technology/Information Technology and allied branches will be eligible for direct admission to the Second Year of B.Sc. (I.T.). However, the Diploma should be recognized by the Board of Technical Education or any other recognized Government Body Minimum Marks required 45% aggregate for Open Category candidates and 40% aggregate for Reserved category candidates.

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Further that the amended Ordinance has been brought into force with effect from the academic year 2004-2005.
