

CIRCULAR :

A reference is invited to the Ordinances and Regulations of the Bachelor of Science in Information Technology (B.Sc.) (I.T.) three year degree course vide this office Circular No.UG-150 of 2001 dated 3rd May, 2001 and the Co-ordinator, Department of Information Technology (B.Sc.) (I.T.) and Principals of the affiliated colleges in Arts, Science and Commerce are hereby informed that the following recommendation made by the ad-hoc Committee appointed by the Academic Council to advise it on all matters relating to the courses of study and examination in the subject of B.Sc. and M.Sc. (Information Technology) at its meeting held on 21st June, 2004 has been accepted by the Academic Council at its meeting held on 7th August, 2004 vide item No.4.16 and subsequently approved by the Management Council at its meeting held on 13th August, 2004 vide item No.6 and that in accordance therewith the Regulation 4411 relating to the standard of passing at the B.Sc. (I.T.) examination has been amended to read as under :-

R.4411 : Passing Standards :

1. A student is said to have passed if he/she secures 40% of marks allotted in each head of passing. Theory of 100 marks and TW Practical/Tutorial of 50 marks are treated as separate heads of passing.
2. A student is said to have passed Semester I if the student passes in all heads of passing of the semester.
3. A student is eligible to be admitted to Semester II irrespective of no. of heads of failure in the First Semester.
4. A student is eligible for admission to Semester III if either the student passes Semesters I & II.
OR
The student fails in a combination of Theory and/or Practical taken in Semester I or Semester II or together, where the total marks does not exceed 200.
5. A student is eligible to be admitted to Semester IV irrespective of no. of heads of failure in the Third Semester. However, the student has to clear Semesters I and II in order to appear for Semester IV examination.

6. A student is eligible for admission to Semester V if either the student passes Semesters III & IV

Or

The student fails in a combination of Theory and/or Practical taken in Semester III or Semester IV or together, where the total marks does not exceed 200.

7. A student is eligible to be admitted to Semester V if a maximum of five of heads of failure in the fifth Semester. The results of Semester VI should be kept in abeyance until the student clears Semesters III, IV and V in full.

8. The class is awarded Semester-wise for Semesters I, II, III and IV. However, Semesters V and VI will be taken together for award of class i.e. in the Final Year.

> Award of class is based on first attempt and not on repeats given in the same sitting.

> Passing in parts will be awarded Pass Class irrespective of the cumulative percentage of marks.

> Distinction is awarded for 75% and above.

> First Class is awarded for 60% and above but below 75%.

> Second Class is awarded for 50% and above but below 60%.

> Pass class is awarded for all below 50%.

9. Examinations for the repeaters will be held 15 days after the declaration of results of the regular examination in Semesters I, II, III and IV.

10. The candidates who are repeaters at the B.Sc. (I.V.) examination shall be granted exemption from reappearing in theory, term work and project if they have secured minimum marks required for passing in these heads at their previous examinations. However, such candidates will not be eligible for a class or any University award.

Further that the amended R.441 I has been brought into force with effect from the academic year 2004-2005.

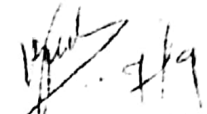
