Sir,

I am to invite your attention to the Bachelor of Technology (B.Tech.) degree course vide Pamphlet No.50 and to this office Circular No.UG/470 of 2004, dated 2nd November,2004 to inform you that the recommendation made by the Board of Studies in Chemical Technology at its meeting held on 16th March,2005 has been accepted by the Academic Council at its meeting held on 2nd April,2005 vide item No.4.46 and that in accordance therewith the **Regulation 4772** relating to the B.Tech. degree course has been amended to read as under :-

R.4722 :-

- (a) For any semester examination, a candidate shall be declared failed if he/she secures less than 50% aggregate marks of all the passing heads of that semester OR he/she fails in two or more heads of passing including Term Work.
- (b) The candidate failing in only Term Work, but has passed in the other heads of passing and also has obtained 50% or more of the aggregate marks in the remaining heads of passing shall be allowed to keep terms (ATKT) for the next semester. Such a candidate may improve the Term Work in the subsequent term after paying the tuition fee for the respective semester.
- (c) If a candidate has failed in some of the subjects heads, including Term Work, such a candidate may be allowed to appear for the repeat examination of the respective semester. Such a candidate may improve the Term Work in the subsequent term after paying the tuition fee for the respective semester.
- (d) The class, as give in R.3949(b), shall not be awarded to candidates who clear the Semesters VII and VIII examinations in parts either through Repeat Tests or Regular semester examinations.

Further that Regulation 4772 relating to the B.Tech. degree course has been brought into force with effect from the examination to be held in the first half of 2005.
