CIRCULAR :-

A reference is invited to the Ordinances Regulations and syllabi relating to the Bachelor of Architecture (B.Arch.) degree course vide pamphlet No.165 and to this office circular Nos.UG/213 of 2004, dated 29th May.2004 and No.UG/214 of 2004, dated 29th May.2004 respectively and Principals of the affiliated colleges in Architecture are hereby informed that the recommendation made by the Ad-hoc Board of Studies in Architecture at its meeting held on 7th October.2004 has been accepted by the Academic Council at its meeting held on 8th October,2004 vide item No.4.30 and that in accordance therewith the candidates who have failed in Semester V and Semester VI examinations of the Bachelor of Architecture (B.Arch.) degree under the old course shall be allowed to take admission and keep terms for the Fourth Year (Semester VII and VIII) of the B.Arch. degree course under the revised course. However, such candidates shall not be allowed to appear for the Fourth Year B.Arch. examination unless they pass in all the papers of Semesters V & VI (Old course) examinations within the stipulated period as mentioned below and appear for the examination in the subject of "Landscape" of the Third Year B.Arch.(revised course) without keeping terms:-

"Semesters V & VI examinations under the B.Arch. old course shall be held for the last time in the second half of 2005. as a special case."

The candidate who have been admitted to the Fourth Year B.Arch. examination under the revised course shall be required to pass in the examination in the subject of "Landscape " of the Third Year of B.Arch.(revised course) before their admission to the Fifth Year of the B.Arch. (revised degree course).

The candidates who have passed in all the papers of Semester I to Semester IV examinations of the B.Arch. degree under the old course, but who have not passed Semester V & VI examinations under the old course and examination in the subject of "Landscape" of the Third Year of the B.Arch.(revised degree course) within the stipulated period shall be allowed to enter upon the Third Year of the B.Arch. degree course and continue with their studies under the revised course.

Similarly the candidates who have not passed Semesters VII and VIII examinations of the B.Arch. degree under the old course, shall be permitted to take admission to the Fifth Year of the B.Arch. (revised degree course). However, such candidates shall not be allowed to appear for the final year examination of the Fifth Year B.Arch., unless they pass in all the papers of Semester VII & VIII (old course) examination conducted within the stipulated period as mentioned below :-

"Semester VII & VIII examination under the B.Arch. old course shall be held for the last time in the second half of 2006."
