

CIRCULAR :

A reference is invited to the Ordinances, Regulations and syllabi relating to the Bachelor of Architecture degree course (B.Arch.) vide pamphlet No.165 and to this office Circular No.UG/103 of 2001 dated 28th March, 2001 and the Principals of the affiliated colleges in Architecture are hereby informed that the recommendation made by the ad-hoc Board of Studies in Architecture at its meeting held on 25th January, 2005 has been accepted by the Academic Council at its meeting held on 5th February, 2005 vide item No.4.39 and subsequently approved by the Management Council at its meeting held on 18th February, 2005 vide item No.6 and that in accordance therewith the Regulation 4370, 4373, 4376, 4379 and 4382 relating to the standard of passing for the First Year, Second Year, Third Year, Fourth Year and Fifth year B.Arch. degree course have been amended to read as under :-

FIRST YEAR B.ARCH.

R.4370 : To pass the examination candidate must obtain 40% of the full marks in Theory and 50% of the full marks in Sessional work.. However, the candidate who has failed either in Theory or Sessional but has obtained passing marks either in Theory or Sessional is, at his own option, be exempted from appearing at Theory or Sessional in which he has passed and the marks obtained in Theory or Sessional in which he has passed shall be carried over to the subsequent examination.

Those successful candidates who obtain 55% of the total marks obtainable in the examination taken at one sitting only will be placed in the Second Class.

Those successful candidates who obtain 60% of the total marks obtainable in the examination taken at one sitting only will be placed in the First Class.

The candidate passing the examination of the First Year at one and the same sitting will only be eligible for award of prize, medal or scholarship.

SECOND YEAR B.ARCH.

R.4373 : To pass the examination candidate must obtain 40% of the full marks in Theory and 50% of the full marks in Sessional work. However, the candidate who has failed either in Theory or Sessional but has obtained the passing marks either in Theory or Sessional is, at his own option, be exempted from appearing at Theory or Sessional in which he has passed and the marks obtained in Theory or Sessional in which he has passed shall be carried over to the subsequent examination.

Those successful candidates who obtain 55% of the total marks obtainable in the examination taken at one sitting only will be placed in the Second Class.

Those successful candidates who obtain 60% of the total marks obtainable in the examination taken at one sitting only will be placed in the First Class.

The candidate passing the examination of the Second Year at one and the same sitting will only be eligible for award of prize, medal or scholarship.

THIRD YEAR B.ARCH.

R.4376 : To pass the examination candidate must obtain 40% of the full marks in Theory and 50% of the full marks in Sessional work. However, the candidate who has failed either in Theory or Sessional but has obtained the passing marks either in Theory or Sessional is, at his own option, be exempted from appearing at Theory or Sessional in which he has passed and the marks obtained in Theory or Sessional in which he has passed shall be carried over to the subsequent examination.

Those successful candidates who obtain 55% of the total marks obtainable in the examination taken at one sitting only will be placed in the Second Class.

Those successful candidates who obtain 60% of the total marks obtainable in the examination taken at one sitting only will be placed in the First Class.

The candidate passing the examination of the Third Year at one and the same sitting will only be eligible for award of prize, medal or scholarship.

FOURTH YEAR B.ARCH.

R.4379 : To pass the examination candidate must obtain 40% of the full marks in Theory and 50% of the full marks in Sessional work. However, the candidate who has failed either in Theory or Sessional but has obtained the passing marks either in Theory or Sessional is, at his own option, be exempted from appearing at Theory or Sessional in which he has passed and the marks obtained in Theory or Sessional in which he has passed shall be carried over to the subsequent examination.

Those successful candidates who obtain 55% of the total marks obtainable in the examination taken at one sitting only will be placed in the Second class.

Those successful candidates who obtain 60% of the total marks obtainable in the examination taken at one sitting only will be placed in the First Class.

The candidate passing the examination of the Fourth Year at one and the same sitting will only be eligible for award of prize, medal or scholarship.

FIFTH YEAR B.ARCH.

R.4382 : To pass the examination candidate must obtain 40% of the full marks in Theory and 50% of the full marks in Sessional work. However, the candidate who has failed either in Theory or Sessional but has obtained the passing marks either in Theory or Sessional is, at his own option, be exempted from appearing at Theory or Sessional in which he had passed and the marks obtained in Theory or Sessional in which he was passed shall be carried over to the subsequent examination.

Those successful candidates who obtain 55% of the total marks obtainable in the examination taken at one sitting only will be placed in the Second Class.

Those successful candidates who obtain 60% of the total marks obtainable in the examination taken at one sitting only will be placed in the First Class.

The candidate passing the examination of the Fifth Year Part I and Part II at one and the same sitting will only be eligible for award of prize, medal or scholarship.

Further the amended Regulations will be brought into force with effect from the academic year 2005-2006.
