

CIRCULAR :

Attention of Principals of the affiliated colleges in the Faculty of Arts and the Principals of the affiliated colleges enrolling students for B.H.T.M.S. course, is hereby invited to the Ordinances, Regulations and Syllabi relating to the Bachelor of Hotel and Tourism Management Studies (B.H.T.M.S.) and they are hereby informed that the recommendation made by Ad-hoc Board of Studies in Bachelor of Hotel and Tourism Management Studies (B.H.T.M.S.) at its meeting held on 16th July, 2005 has been accepted by the Academic Council at its meeting held on 6th August, 2005 vide item No. 4.21 and that in accordance therewith, since six month Industrial Training is a necessary aspect in the Second Year B.H.T.M.S., there should be allocation of grading from the industry i.e., the students should obtain minimum 'B' grade in Industrial Training. However, if the student fails to obtain the minimum required 'B' grade, he/she will have to repeat the Industrial Training in the same industry. Therefore, if the student does not complete the Industrial Training, he/she will not be allowed to take admission in the Final Year of B.H.T.M.S. (A= Excellent 70% and above; B+=60% to 69% b=50% to 59%; C= Below 50%).

Further that the above recommendation has been brought into force with effect from the academic year 2005-2006.
