

CIRCULAR :

A reference is invited to the Ordinances, Regulations and syllabus relating to the Bachelor of Science (Bio-technology) degree course pamphlet No.340 and to this office Circular No.UG/216 of 2002 dated 16th May, 2002 and the Principals of the affiliated colleges in Science are hereby informed that the proposal for guidelines, procedure for admission relating to the B.Sc. (Information Technology) degree course to be introduced from the academic year 2007-2008 has been accepted by the Academic Council at its meeting held on 12th June, 2007 *vide* item No.4.16 and subsequently approved by the Management Council at its meeting held on 15th June, 2007 *vide* item No.17 and that, in accordance therewith, Ordinance 5108 relating to the B.Sc. (Bio-technology) degree course has been amended to read as under:-

"O.5108:- B.Sc. (Bio-Technology)

A candidate for being eligible for admission to the Three year Integrated course leading to the degree of Bachelor of Science (B.Sc.) must have passed Higher Secondary School Certificate Examination (Std.XII) in Science conducted by the Maharashtra State Board of Secondary and Higher Secondary Education or its equivalent in Science stream.

Admission will be on merit, based on order of preference as follows:

1. Aggregate Marks at H.S.C. or equivalent.
2. Aggregate Marks in Science Group (Physics, Chemistry and Biology)
3. Marks in Biology and Chemistry.
4. Marks in Biology.

A candidate who has not offered Mathematics and Statistics as one of the Subject at H.S.C. (Std.XII) shall have to satisfactorily complete a course in Mathematics and Statistics (of 15 hours duration) during the academic year of First year B.Sc. in which he is admitted.

Intake Capacity 35.

However, if the repeaters are admitted in S.Y.B.Sc. or in T.Y.B.Sc. in addition to regular students of the same College, new batch to be started if the strength exceeds 45 students subject to permission of University and Government."

Further, I am to inform you that in exercise of the powers conferred upon the Management Council under Section 54(1) of the Maharashtra Universities Act, 1994 has amended the afore said Ordinance 5108 relating to the B.Sc. (Bio-technology) degree course and that the same has been brought into force with effect from the academic year 2007-2008.
